The teacher's noted when it was only class specific as opposed to being a requirement for all students taking a course in that area of study (i.e., English).

English Department

English 7: 3 ring binder with 5 dividers. 2 pocket folders with brads, colored pencils, highlighters, colored pens, lined paper, I use the ipad everyday, so the school ipad must be charged everyday, but please keep an extra ipad charger in your bag everyday.

English 8: 3 ring binder with 5 dividers, 2 pocket folders with brads, colored pencils, highlighters, colored pens, lined notebook paper, and please have your school iPad charged daily.

World History 8: Notebook paper, 1-inch binder with pockets or sturdy folder with pockets on both sides, pencils - mechanical preferred, Expo markers, Index cards

7th Accelerated Pre-Alg: Spiral Notebook for homework, 1 Folder with brads and pockets, pencil pouch, pencils, red pen, colored pencils, scissors, tape, glue stick, Expo Markers – plenty of these, 1.5 inch binder, loose-leaf paper, graph paper, 2 Dividers (for Notes, Handouts), Calculator TI-**30X**IIS

8th Grade Pre-Algebra College Prep: Notebook paper, Graph paper, 1-inch binder with pockets or sturdy folder with pockets on both sides, Pencils - mechanical preferred, Expo markers

8th Grade Math Team: Notebook paper, Graph paper, 1-inch binder with pockets or sturdy folder with pockets on both sides, Pencils - mechanical preferred, Expo markers, Index cards

Accelerated Alg: Spiral Notebook for homework, 1 Folder with brads and pockets, Pencil pouch, pencils, red pen, colored pencils, scissors, tape, glue stick, Expo Markers – plenty of these, 1.5 inch binder, loose-leaf paper, graph paper, 2 Dividers (for Notes, Handouts), Calculator TI-30XIIS

Science Department

Health:1 or 1.5 inch binder with notebook paper, pens or pencils, poster board, index cards.

Science 7: A set of bound index cards and loose-leaf paper, Pens (blue/black and red), Expo Markers, Colored pencils, 2" three-ring binder—binder may be shared with another subject--dividers are optional but may be helpful, Folder with brads

Science 8: 2" binder (with a clear cover) - can be shared with another subject, any calculator with square root function-you can use the same calculator that you use in math, clear, flexible ruler for graphing

JH Español 1: A notebook for students that want hard copies of work instead of using the iPad and iPad stylus. When using a notebook the student needs *pocket* dividers, lined notebook paper, pens/pencils, colored pens for corrections, erasable markers for games, dry erase markers, and 3x5 lined index cards.
