

OLDHAM COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION POLICY

ACCREDITATION

4005

The policy of the Board is to offer the highest possible level of instruction. The board will continuously strive to develop or hire highly qualified teachers, who are certified by the Commonwealth of Kentucky for the field in which they teach. The board requires that students receive instruction that is directed by a Kentucky certified teacher. Instructional aides may implement instruction planned and directly supervised by a certified teacher. Only the certified teacher may be responsible for evaluating student performance in order to determine progress or assign grades. As part of the efforts to accomplish this, the board will develop and adopt a plan for improvement of instruction.

1. The plan will follow the state-mandated District Comprehensive Improvement Plan (CDIP).
2. The plan will be developed as a means of support to schools in meeting their instructional needs.
3. The plan will be presented to the Board for final approval no later than the December meeting.
4. A report on progress toward CDIP goals is to be presented in April to the Board.

In keeping with this goal, the Board strives to maintain high ratings with the following:

4005.01 KENTUCKY DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION

All public schools in Oldham County shall strive to achieve the highest rating and shall make all necessary reports and studies as required by the State Board of Education.

4005.02 SOUTHERN ASSOCIATION OF COLLEGES AND SCHOOLS

Beginning with the 2020-2021 school year the Oldham County School District shall maintain membership in the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools and shall make all necessary reports and studies as required by said association.
