Our application for the 2022-2023 school year will open Oct. 1, 2021, and our priority application deadline is Jan. 7, 2022.

How much does it cost to attend BSM each year?

For the 2022-2023 school year, tuition for our Senior High is \$16,520 and our Junior High tuition is \$14,155. Typically, annual tuition increases are between 1-3%. Additionally, there is a \$200 registration fee and \$400 technology fee.
