Former Pastor of OLGC, Rev. John M. O'Neill, OSFS died July 9, 2022.

An Oblate of St. Francis de Sales for 57 years, Rev. John M. O'Neill from Wilmington, DE professed first vows in 1964, made his perpetual profession in 1967, and was ordained in 1973. Over the years, Father O'Neill worked in a wide variety of ministries in Secondary Education, including St. Francis de Sales HS (Toledo, OH), Bishop Duffy HS (Niagara Falls, NY), Bishop Ireton HS (Alexandria, VA), Bishop Verot HS (Fort Myers, FL), Archbishop Wood HS (Warminster, PA) and Paul VI HS, (Fairfax, VA). His experiences in parochial ministry included being Parochial Vicar/Pastor at Our Lady of Good Counsel Parish (Vienna, VA), Parochial Vicar/Pastor at St. Ann Parish (Naples, Florida) and part-time Parochial Vicar at Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary Parish (Colesville, PA). He also served as Assistant to the President at De Sales University. The Mass of Christian Burial took place on July 14, 2022. YOU'RE NEVER TOO OLD TO KEEP LEARNING Cont'd.

If you're an older adult looking to keep your mind stimulated, your health plan can be a great place to start. Some health plans offer their members additional support through programs like Aetna Medicare's "Resources for Living". These programs can connect older adults with community services and resources that can create much needed cognitive stimulation through recreational activities and volunteer opportunities. Participation in health plan fitness programs like "Silver Sneakers" can also keep your mind active and engaged, while improving your physical health. You may even find new friends with whom to play a game of pickle ball or take a bike ride!

There are lifelong learning programs for older adults right here in Fairfax County. Look no further than two dynamic programs for older adults associated with higher education institutions. The Lifetime Learning Institute of Northern Virginia (LLI/NOVA), affiliated with Northern Virginia Community College, and the Osher Lifelong Learning Institute (OLLI) at George Mason University both offer opportunities for older adults to explore courses on a wide variety of subjects and attend cultural and social events. The courses are not offered for college credit or toward degree programs but both organizations offer membership options to access the course offerings and events.

LLI/NOVA

LLI/NOVA is a non-profit volunteer-driven organization that offers stimulating and cultural pursuits for adults 50 and over. Members sign up for as many classes as they want by joining for \$110 annually. An entire online course catalog is published three times a year with 130+ stimulating classes presented via Zoom or in-person. The classes are taught by volunteers, many of whom are college professors or other experts in their fields. The classes cover many different topics, including history, foreign affairs, science, financial and retirement planning, political science, government, technology, philosophy, psychology, religion, music, art, poetry and personal development. They also offer travel and cultural excursions, including programs to visit local museums, the theatre and native preserves. The study/travel destinations being considered for 2023 are the Rhine River, highlights of Ireland and Australia/New Zealand. Those interested in joining special interest groups have a wide variety of options including bridge and other games, photography, finances, food from around the world and various book groups. OLLI/GMU

OLLI is also a volunteer-led, non-profit organization that provides opportunities for older adults to explore intellectual and cultural subjects, discover new abilities, and socialize with others who share similar interests. The annual membership of \$450 includes registration to attend an unlimited number of courses, trips, luncheons, parties, and picnics scheduled throughout the year. They offer a special introductory rate for anyone who wants to try out their courses and activities for a shortened time. Daytime academic courses, special events and cultural activities are offered at three area locations: Fairfax, Reston and Sterling, with some courses offered virtually. They are taught by wellqualified OLLI members and well-known teachers from GMU, government, foreign embassies, and private industry. Music, finance, languages, current events, science, technology, health and many more course subjects are offered. Interested in learning more about regional landmarks and historical sites? OLLI offers excursions to battlefields, wineries and other nearby destinations. OLLI has more than two dozen clubs and special interest groups for members who enjoy art, history, theater, investing, books and more. Additionally, members with an annual membership are entitled to a GMU ID card which provides library privileges, a discounted GMU gym membership, and other benefits. Vienna Community Center (VCC)

Closer to home, there's the Vienna Community Center (VCC) where a huge array of classes is offered yearlong. Many are devoted to exercise. There's a special section in the seasonal catalog that focuses on older adults. It's here you'll find free weekly one-hour information sessions dealing with senior issues, and trips to area wineries, historical sites, theatre productions, and other adventures. Stop by the VCC for more information.

Shepherd's Center of Northern Virginia

And I saved the best for last! Adventures in Learning, the long-running educational arm of the Shepherd's Center of Northern Virginia, offers weekly classes throughout three semesters during the year. It's very affordable at only \$55 per 8-week semester, and the program offers extremely interesting and helpful classes. The Foreign Affairs program is especially attractive and is a very popular with registrants. Classes are held at Unitarian Universalist Congregation of Fairfax, 2709 Hunter Mill Rd., Oakton on Thursdays, from 9 am – 2 pm. At this time, there's a summer hiatus in place, but things will be gearing up in a couple of months for the Fall Semester.

There are many opportunities in Northern Virginia to keep mentally and physically active. The classes and events offered by the organizations listed combine the benefits of learning, developing new friendships, traveling, and indulging in special interests. There is something for anyone interested in continuing lifelong learning!
