### Ballet:

Students may also wear ballet skirt or warm up shorts over leotard. Hair must be worn off the face and neck. Ballet warm ups may also be worn over leotards. Write students name inside of each shoe with fine tip sharpie.

Jazz/Character/Musicals: Prefer tan or black jazz shoe. Bear paws/Foot undies and Certain athletic shoes permissible. Lightweight comfortable top(must cover mid section), shorts, leggings or yoga pants (Athletic pants and T-shirts for boys acceptable). Clothing must be modest and cover mid section and body appropriately with no offensive writing. Jump up and down, go upside down- If your skin shows, it must be covered. Proper undergarments with proper support are also expected to be worn under clothing at all times. Write students name inside of each shoe with fine tip sharpie.

No jewelry that dangles as this is a safety hazard not only to the student but also to class/teammates-This includes all piercings, necklaces, bracelets and dangled hair accessories.

\*Student discounts are offered at some valley dance wear suppliers- Please tell store clerk you or your child are a student at NVCA in the Performing Arts Program. You will be asked for your student ID card as proof and if you don't have your school ID, you will need to provide my name. I also would like to recommend discountdance.com for online purchases however, you should go in-person to get properly fitted for ballet/jazz shoes if you are purchasing them for the first time. Dance shoes are different from street shoes and dance shoes too large(baggy) or too small will cause pain or injury to a dancers feet. Please do not purchase house slippers from Walmart as ballet slippers. Ballet shoes should be split-sole canvas only. Students can leave their dance shoes & attire in my classroom in cubbies to cut down on bulk weight in their backpacks. I ask that the students provide a small bag(preferably an aerating bag) for their shoes and either a small garment bag(Walmart has them inexpensive) or white garbage back to go over their hangers to protect their leotards and tights. Students will be given time to change. Students with any special needs will be accommodated. There may be on special occasion the need to purchase a costume or costume piece for a dance performance. Every effort will be made to either rent or find something reasonably priced or creatively put together with pieces a student has for some dance numbers. Costumes can range from \$30-60, so please plan accordingly.

A note about theater Make-up: Theatrical make up is worn by both male and female actors, all news TV anchors/broadcasters, dancers, celebrities and others on film, TV or stage. Lighting conditions on a stage or on camera wash out the pigmentation in human skin. Make-up is used to color correct these effects as well as contour, create characters (fantasy or real), re-create realistic trauma injuries, or make and old age face on a younger person or make an old person look young. Make-up is a staple under a variety of lighting conditions- low light, black light, natural light and artificial light depending on what we need to create in various scenes/situations.
