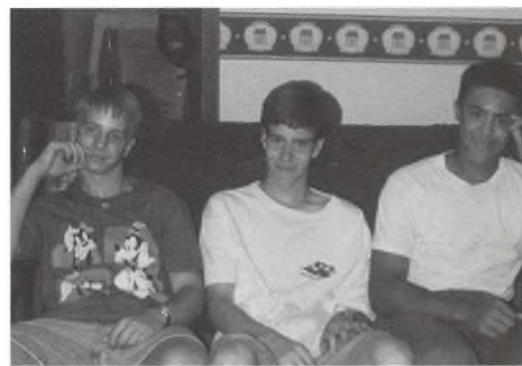
Ron continues to live out his dream. "Just being around the other cowboys and stock creates such a rush when I ride!" exclaims Ron.
