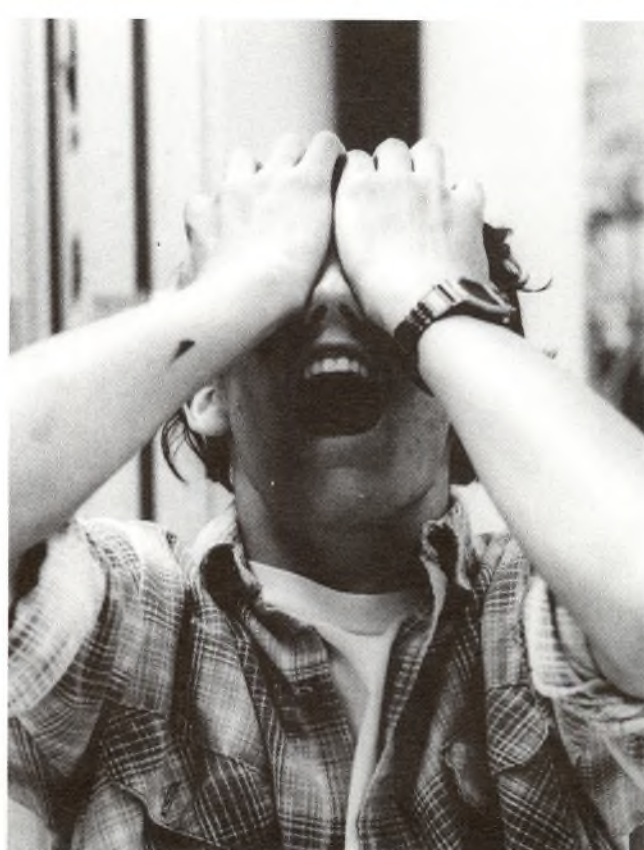
Somedays, I am searching,
