I'll spend all of my time trying to find a certain piece, then realize I'm looking at the section wrong. Instead of a dog's ear, I'm supposed to be looking for part of the green roof. When we're kids and as we go through school, we find pieces all around us, but how do they fit in? I guess that directly relates to schoolwork. How many times a week does someone in advanced math class say, "Mr Zylstra, what bearing is this going to have on my life? I don't think that the ability to draw a parabola is going to come up again ever."

We spend spectacular summers with our friends and begin piecing together sections that we'll keep adding to.












And even though we may get most of our puzzle pieces together before we die, or even if we only get some of the pieces together, we will see the entire puzzle completed in heaven, finished to the perfection that God planned for it.

I guess I have reached a conclusion and I hope you understood what I was trying to say. If you didn't, don't read this introduction again for a couple of years.
