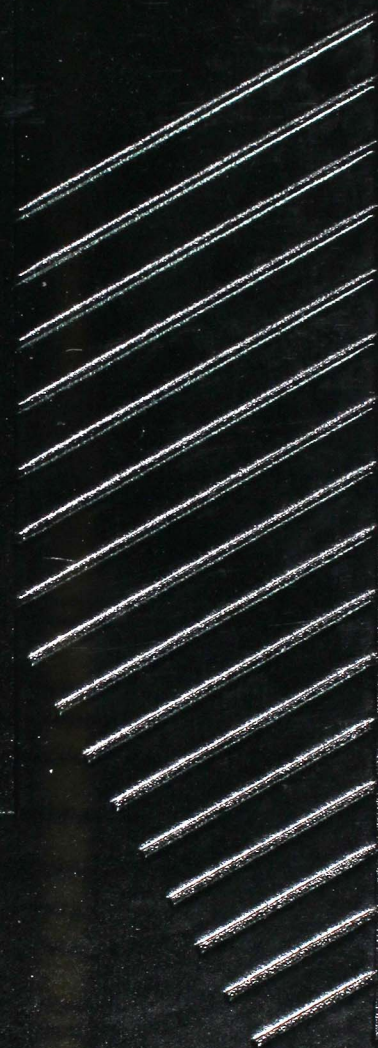

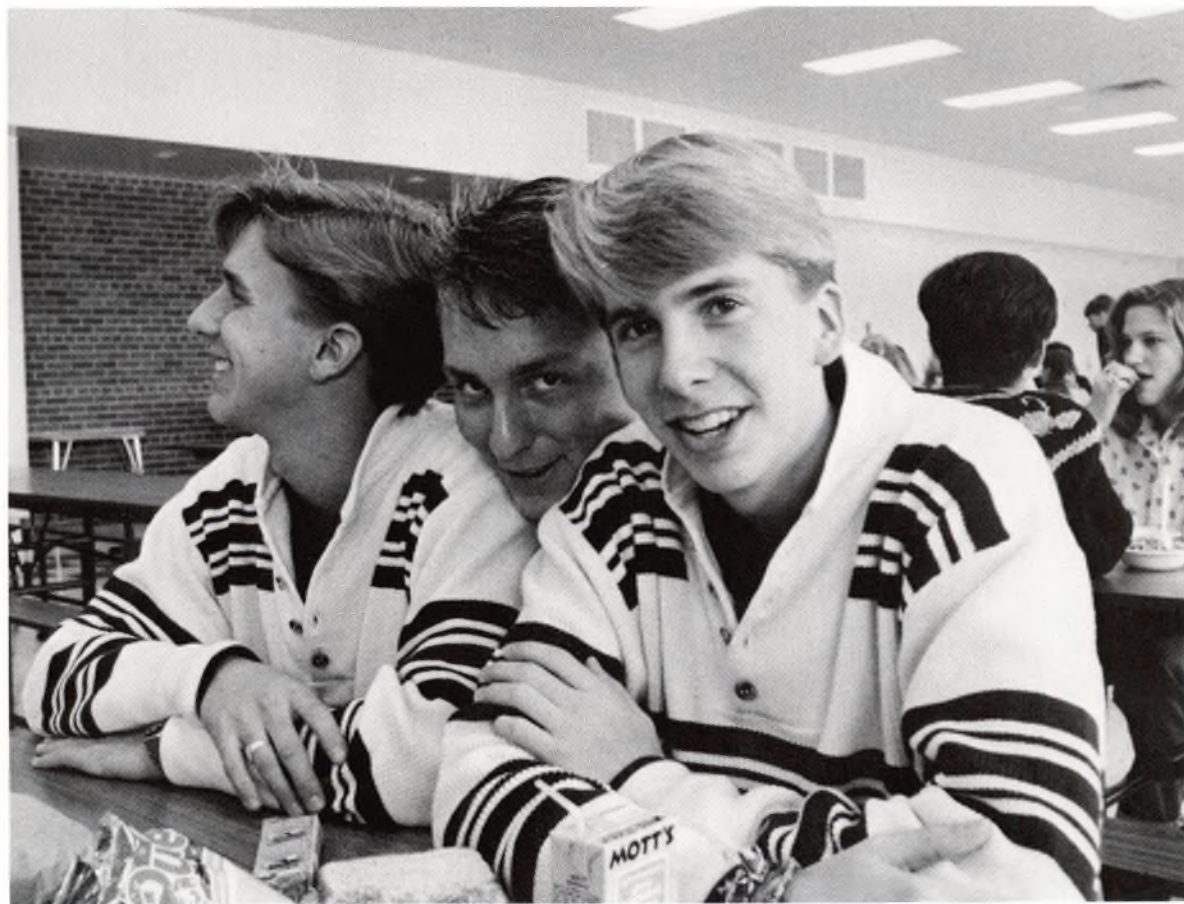

table gets bumped or jiggled the wrong way and the pieces come apart. Not all pieces come apart but some do. All puzzles are different.

Since I'm not allowed to look at the box, finding the first few pieces is pretty difficult. Everything's sitting in front of me but I can't see how the pieces fit. I'll spend all of my time trying to find a certain piece, then realize I'm looking at the section wrong. Instead of a dog's ear, I'm supposed to be looking for part of the green roof. When we're kids and as we go through school, we find pieces all around us, but how do they fit in? I guess that directly relates to schoolwork. How many times a week does someone in advanced math class say, "Mr Zylstra, what bearing is this going to have on my life? I don't think that the ability to draw a parabola is going to come up again ever."

Grade school is kind of like picking up the pieces: making new friends, seeing new places and learning new things. In junior high we start to try to fit the pieces in. We test things, but we have all kinds of firsts: date, kiss, "A" on a term paper, free throw basket, the list goes on and on. We have the pieces in

our hands, but they don't seem to fit. By high school, some of the pieces are making sense. We can figure out where they belong. Our plans for the future begin to develop, too, so we're still gathering pieces. That goes on for our entire lives, but during high school, things are beginning to fit together. We realize that dating in junior high was stupid, or maybe it was worth the heartache? We spend spectacular summers with our friends and begin piecing together sections that we'll keep adding to.



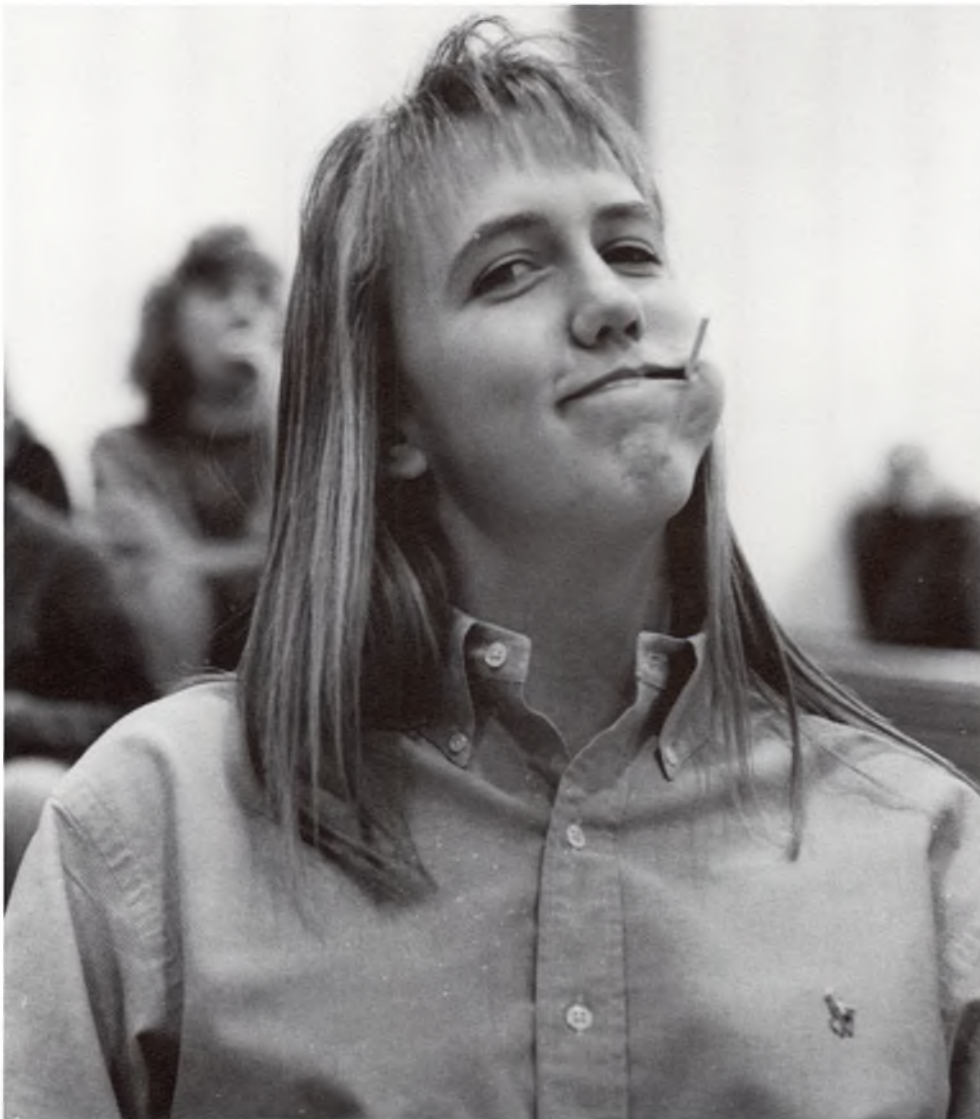

Through the rest of our lives, we will continue to gather pieces and put others together. It's an ongoing challenge to make sure the pieces fit together just right.

No two puzzles are the same and no two people are the same either. What fits into one puzzle and is wonderful may be hurtful and uncooperative in another. We all interpret each piece differently. And even though we may get most of our puzzle pieces together before we die, or even if we only get some of the pieces together, we will see the entire puzzle completed in heaven, finished to the perfection that God planned for it.

I guess I have reached a conclusion and I hope you understood what I was trying to say. If you didn't, don't read this introduction again for a couple of years.

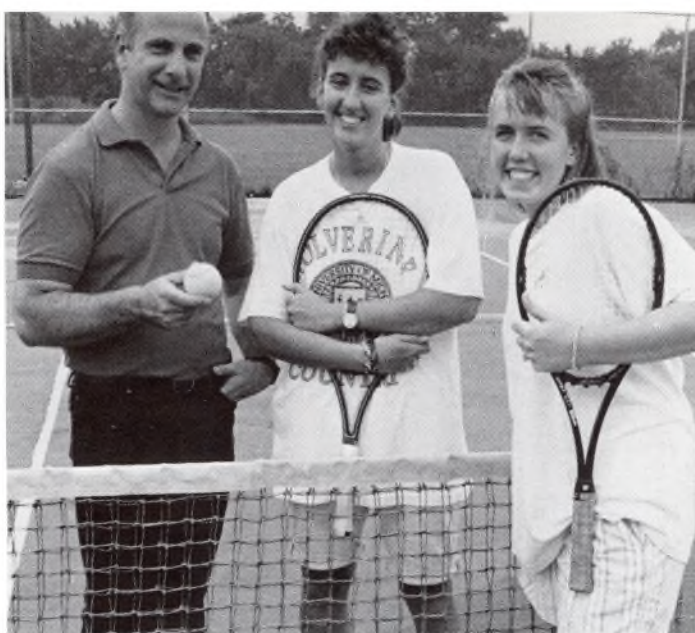

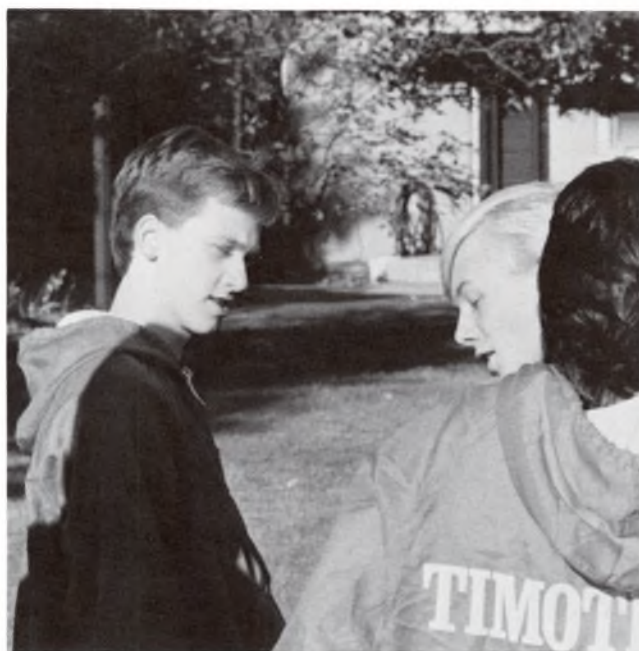

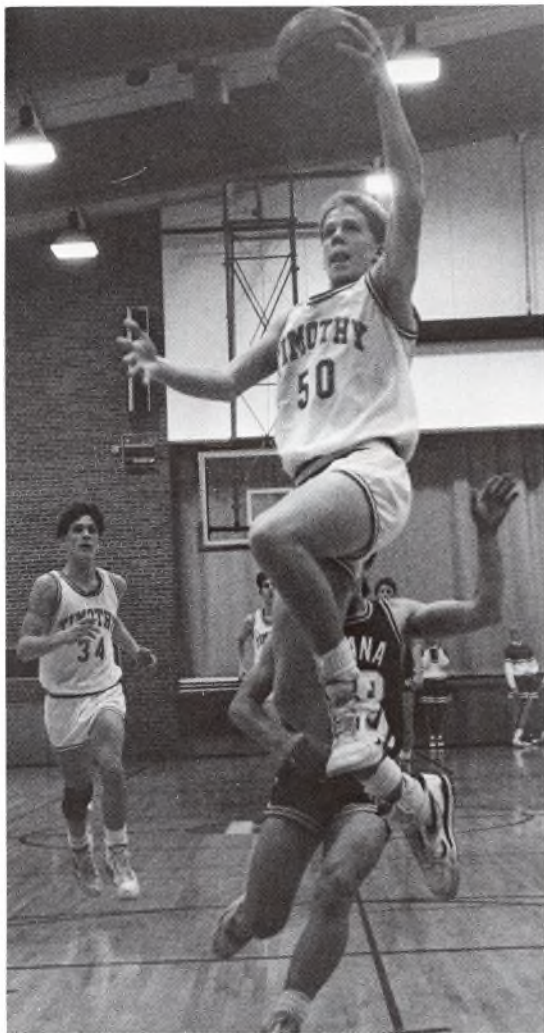
