








When I was a kid, life was not all an analysis of the world as I like to imagine that it was. I had real concerns about when Dad would get home from work, if my parents would leave me with a babysitter forever so they could live somewhere else, what a new baby in the house would be like, and why my neighborhood friends didn't go to church like I did. Some of this may sound silly, but for a three-year-old these were complex issues. I had "sophisticated" conversations with my parents about these worries, and they'd explain things and reassure me. Knowing that my parents loved me was my greatest comfort. I was truly blessed because my parents worked at teaching me and leading me in the direction of Christ. Before and after meals and before bed at night, I repeated in rhythm the prayers of "Lord bless this food" and "Now I lay me down to sleep." Mom's favorite phrases still echo in the back of my mind saying, "Think before you talk," and "Put yourself in the other person's shoes." Mom and I had other meaningful moments sitting on the couch waiting for Dad to get home from work. We'd sing "The wise man built his house upon the Rock" again and again until the little blue volkswagon bug coasted

up the driveway. I remember asking my mom what the words to the song meant, and she said Jesus was the Rock and the sand was the wealth or power that people misplace their trust in. I don't think I understood at the time, but I still haven't forgotten it.

Timothy grade school also had an affect on me. Prayer became the natural thing to do at the beginning and end of each school day. In second grade I remember folding my hands over my eyes and peeking through the spaces between my fingers at the rest of the class which was generally doing the same secretive scanning as I was Although I didn't have too much concentration on prayer at this age, somehow the repeated practice became a necessity for the day. The Luke 2 Christmas story and the joyful noise psalm are now unforgettable because we learned and relearned then each year. During fourth grade, I remembe Miss Beezhold giving us five minutes at the end of each day to read the Bible. And ther there were the wing sings with Mr. Bosmar and Mr. Lanenga on their guitars and all o us singing "Jesus met the woman at the well" and "Red is the color of the blood" with all our hearts and lungs.
















High school itself has had a lot of influence on me. Now we not only have the Christian school atmosphere which most of us have been in all of our lives, but we also have students who are trusting in God during their own tough situations. Once people start raising their hands for the prayer chapels, the requests go on and on. And this year more than any other, students have had the courage to lead chapel. Some of the most meaningful chapels for me were when Kristen told about her mom's struggle with cancer and challenged us to take advantage of the time we have with our parents and when Antoinette shared the troubles she had and how she was able to trust in God. I think one of the most difficult times for many of us was last year when we were all shocked with the death of Kristy. It was so easy to remember her smile and cackling laugh which echoed down the hall that we could hardly comprehend that she was gone. I know she'll always be a part of this year's graduating class even though she's not right here with us.

So far many of us have a shopping cart Christianity where we've looked out at the world, but we've always been kept in the cart and pushed along in the right direction. Now we are deciding either to live like Christ's example or to leave all this Christianity behind with high school. We have such an advantage because we already know so much about Him, and if we just let Him lead us, He will.




# FRESHMEN INITIATION

- Finally REVENGE!




















