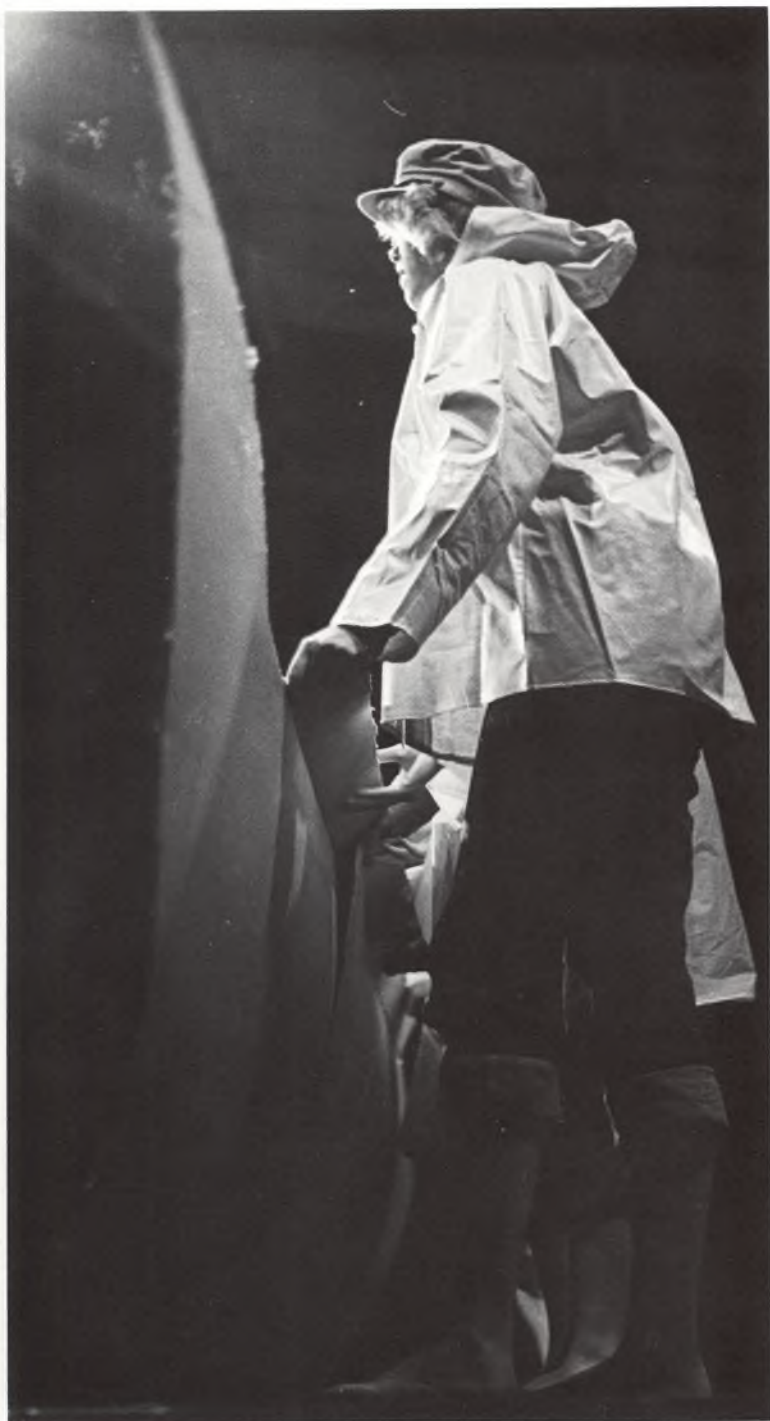
Science

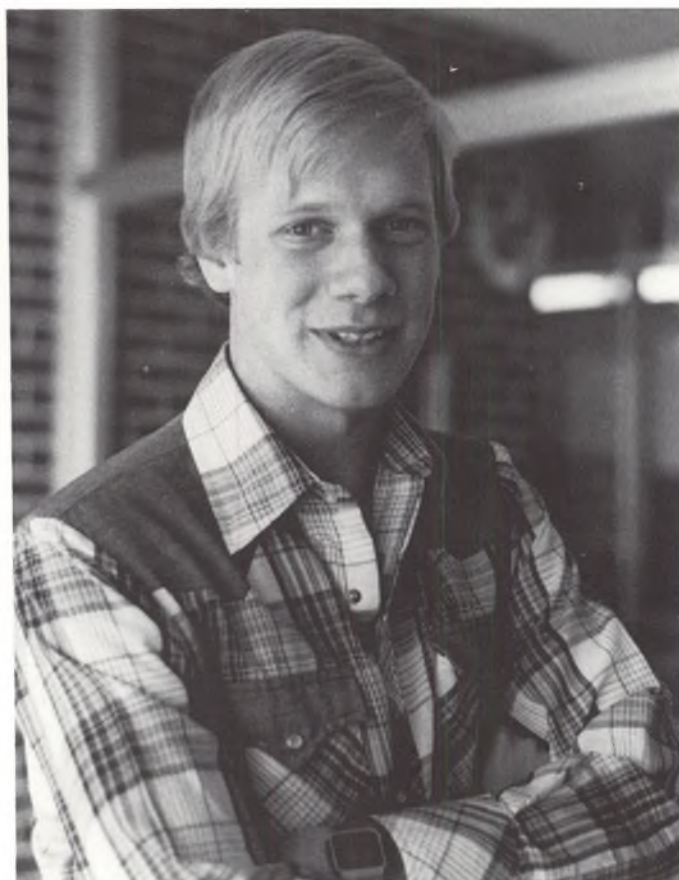

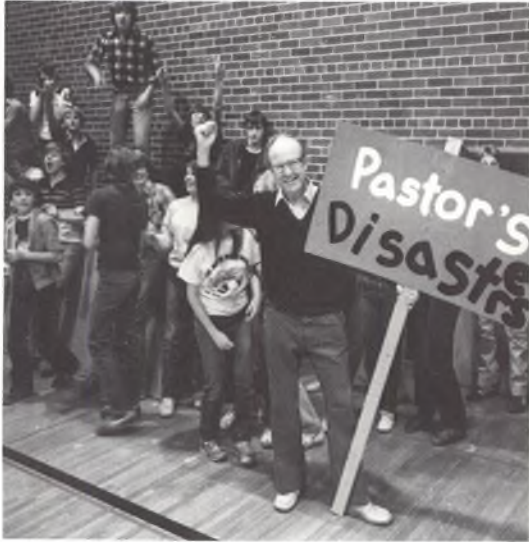

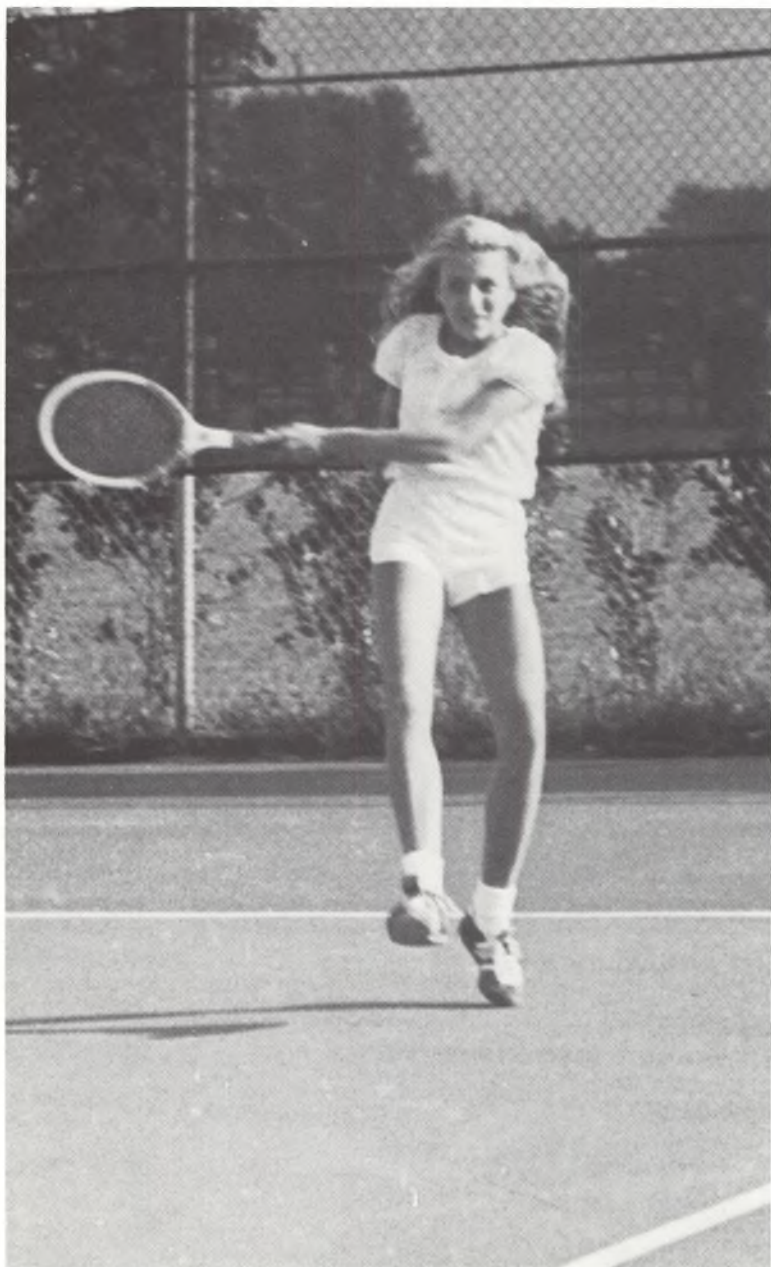

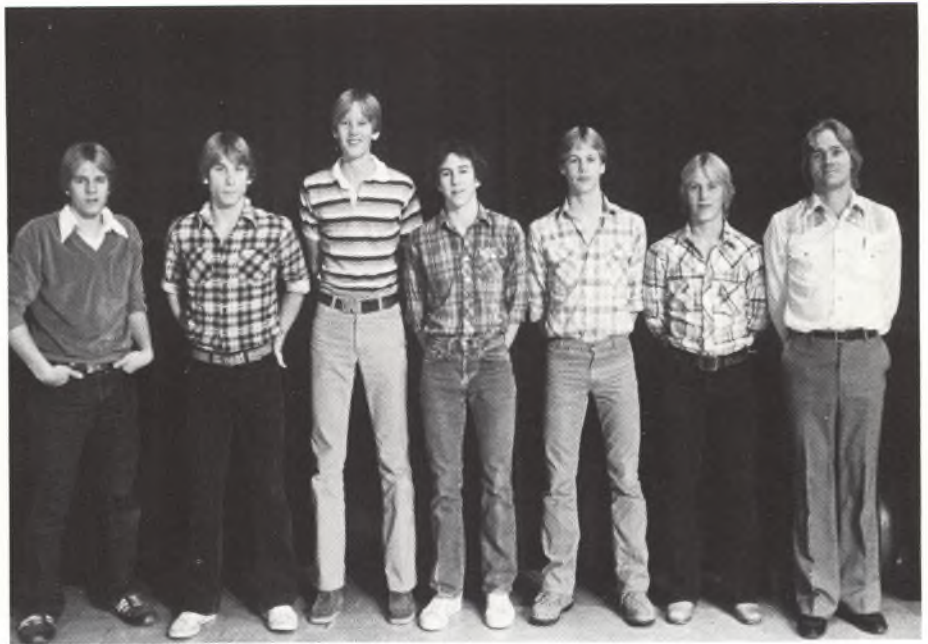

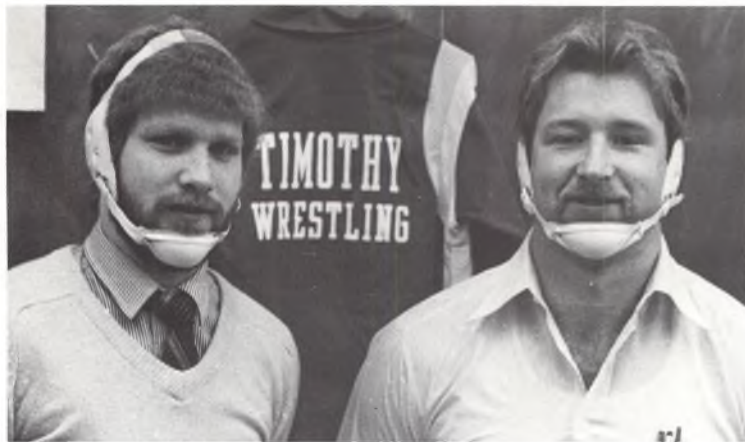
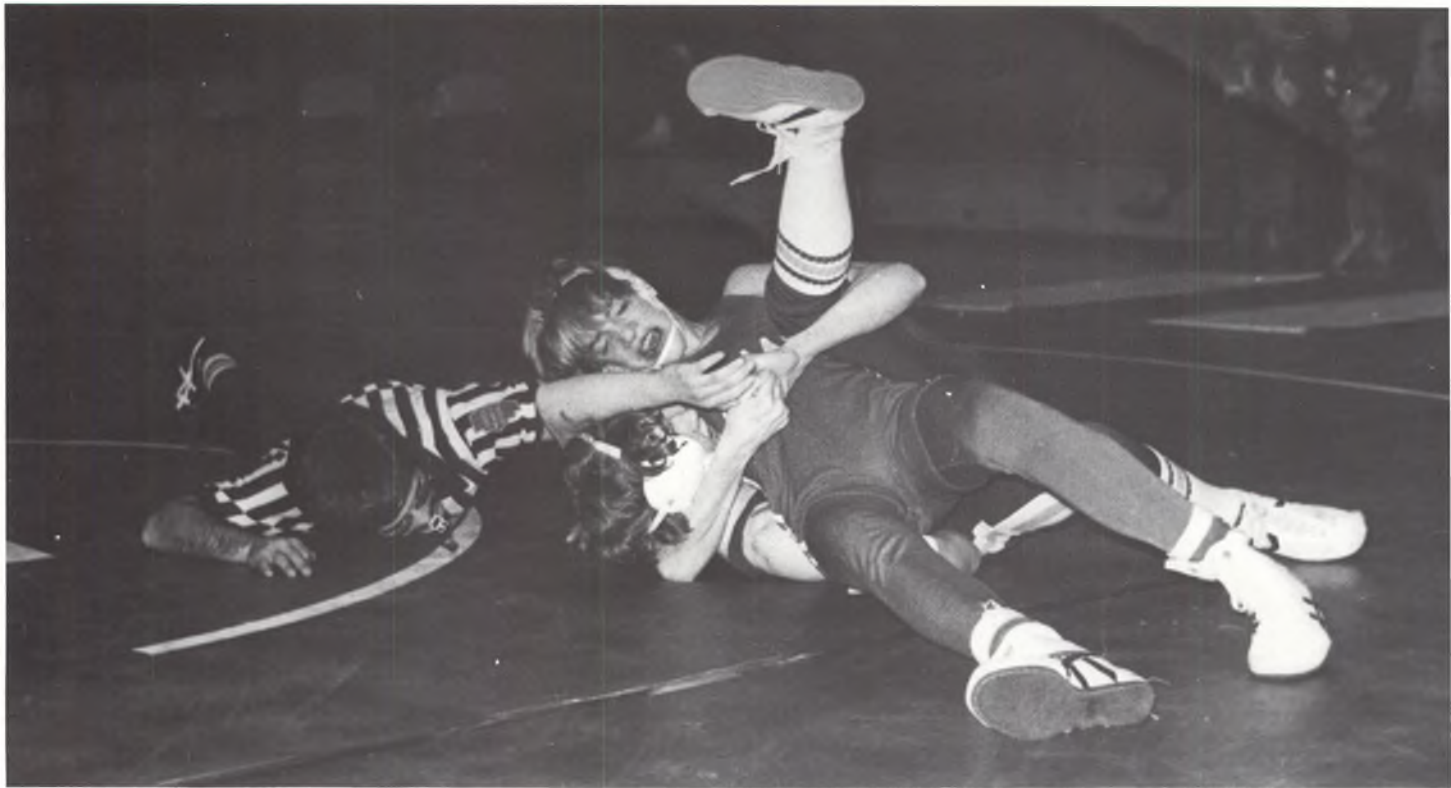


Varsity B-Ball Regional Champs Once Again

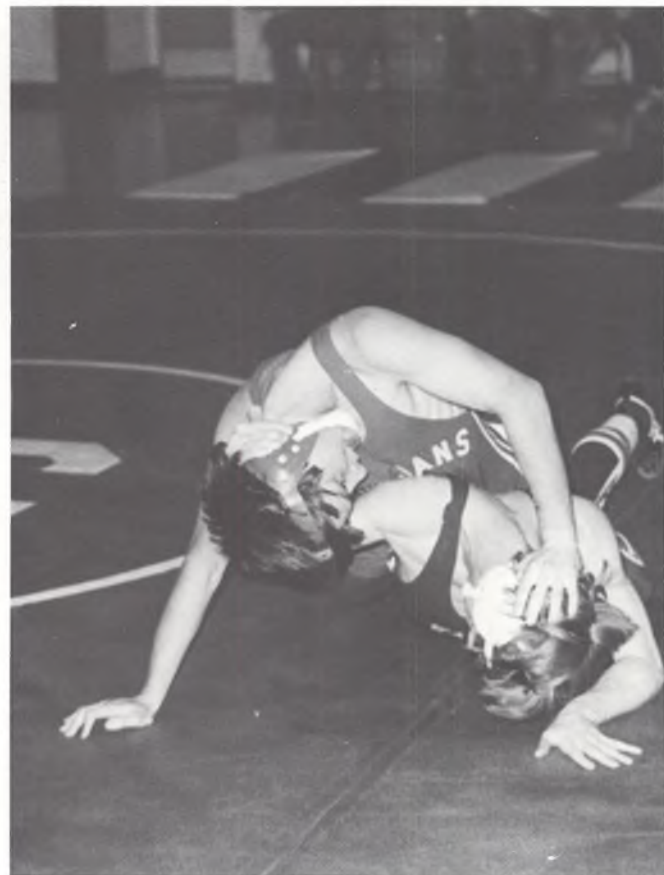

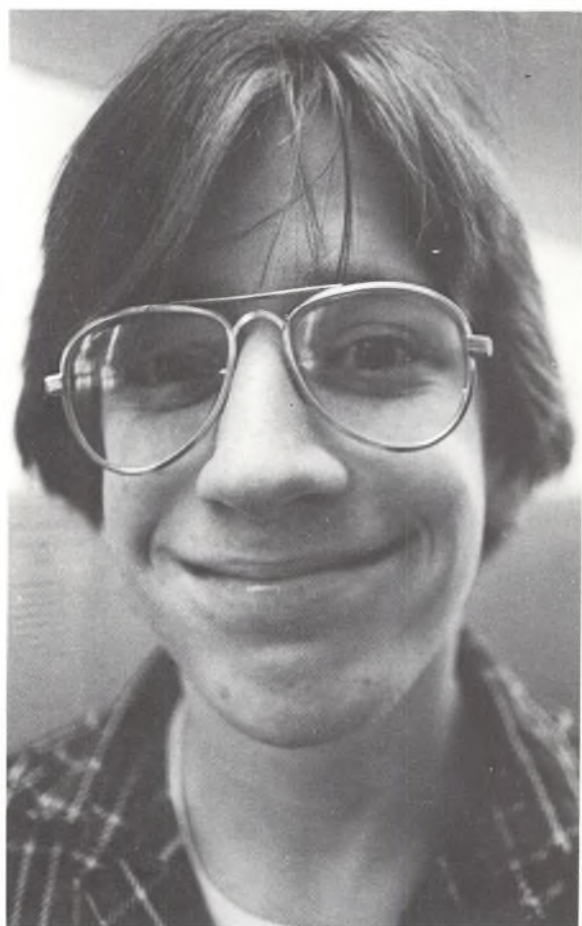
