## A glimpse of the IBDP 2021-22 Results

The IBDP results are in! Not surprisingly, our students and teachers have done amazing work. For another year running, we celebrate our 100% pass rate. This is an enormous testament to SIS' commitment to inclusion and support for our students!



In referring to the IB Bilingual Diploma, Smith highlights SIS' dedication to language learning. We are very honored to graduate students who are academically fluent in at least two languages. This level of skillset is extremely attractive to universities as it demonstrates a broad intellectual capability. Over the last 2 years at SIS, we have worked hard to increase the number of Bilingual Diplomas earned, from 19% in 2020 to 38% in 2022! Congratulations students and teachers!

Academic achievement is a significant component of our holistic approach as a school. As such, we are hugely proud of the 2022 graduating class, which earned an IBDP average of 35.2 points - more than 3 points above the global average of 31.98. Significantly, three of our students received full marks, 45/45, which is a feat achieved by less than 0.25% of all DP candidates worldwide! Seven students achieved a score of 40 points or higher, which positions them to enter the most selective of universities around the globe.
