I authorize Elgin Math and Science Academy Charter School (EMSA) and its employees and agents, to allow my child or ward to possess and use his or her asthma medication and/or epinephrine auto-injector: (1) while in school, (2) while at school-sponsored activity, (3) while under the supervision of school personnel, or (4) before or after normal school activities, such as while in before-school or after-school care on school-operated property. Illinois law requires EMSA to inform the parent/guardian that it, and its employees and agents, incur no liability, except for willful and wanton conduct, as a result of any injury arising from a student's self-administration of medication or epinephrine auto-injector (105 ILCS 5122-30). **For All parent/guardian(s) of a student attending EMSA:**

I hereby confirm my primary responsibility to administer medication to my child. However, in the event that I am unable to do so, I hereby authorize EMSA and its employees and agents, in my behalf and stead, to administer or attempt to administer to my child or allow my child to self-administer, if physician approved. I acknowledge that it may be necessary that the administration of medications to my child be performed by an individual other than a school nurse, and specifically consent to such practices. I further acknowledge and agree that, when the medication is to administered or attempted to be administered, I waive any claims I might have against the School District, its employees and agents arising out of the administration of said medication. In addition, I agree to hold harmless and indemnify the School District, its employees and agents, either jointly or severally, from and against any and all claim, damages, causes of action or injuries and/or death incurred or resulting from the administration or attempts at administration of said medication. I recognize that I am responsible at the end of treatment period for removing from the school any unused medication that was authorized for my child. If I do not pick up the medication by the end of the school year, the principal will dispose of it.
