At dismissal, there are buses and many parents in cars picking their children up from school, and this can create a congested situation. Because of this, we feel the need to organize the walkers before they leave the building.

If you want your child to walk home or to any other location you allow, please sign below indicating that you have read this letter. We will gather the students who have permission to walk in the cafeteria and dismiss them together at approximately 3:20pm, or after bus and car traffic has dispersed. Please be advised that students are not supervised while walking from school or to the Mason Community Center. Any student who does not have permission to walk will be required to ride the bus home, or be a car rider.

By signing below, you indicate that your child may walk from school at any time this year, and ***no additional note will ever be needed all year, as long as this form has been completed.*** If you would prefer that your child not have walking privileges for the entire year, but on an 'as needed' basis, please send a note to the receptionist each time that you would like them to walk. Your child will always need your verbal permission to walk. Thank you for your cooperation, understanding, and continued support.
