2430.1 STUDENT ACTIVITY FEES

The Board of Education recognizes the value that athletics and extracurricular activities play in the life of the district's high school students. Given the realities of budget however, it is necessary that student participants help defray the expense of providing these important programs. As a result, beginning with the fall 2009 school year, a student user activity fee will be required of all high school participants. The proceeds of the fee will be used to support ongoing athletics operational expenses. Payment of the fee does not entitle students to any specific benefit (including playing time), save for membership on or in some sport team or club. Once a student is accepted onto a team or club and the fee is paid, there are no refunds of the fee for any reason. The district reserves the right to waive the user fee for any student that can demonstrate financial need (based on the district's definition of need).

Student user fees for Mt. Olive High School are as follows:

\$150 per student for an unlimited number of sports, including marching band

\$50 per student for an unlimited number of clubs and activities
