On Tuesday, September 12, at roughly 4:15 p.m. CST, **Mark Vande Hei** '85 launched into orbit from the Baikonur Cosmodrome in Kazakhstan on Soyuz Expeditions 53/54. Along with fellow NASA astronaut Joe Acaba and cosmonaut Alexander Misurkin of the Russian space agency Roscosmos, Vande Hei left for the International Space Station (ISS) where he will remain until late February. During his time on board the ISS, he will be running a number of scientific experiments that would otherwise not be possible on Earth.

Vande Hei took some time out of his busy schedule to answer a few questions for the BSM community and reflect on what being a Red Knight has meant in his life.

When did you first realize you wanted to become an astronaut?

My whole life, I always thought that being an astronaut would be cool, but I also thought that about being a professional football player, a doctor, or a super hero. I never gave it much thought until my first assignment in the Army when my company commander, who knew that I had a bachelor's degree in Physics, handed me a memo saying that the Army was looking for soldiers to apply to become astronauts. I met the minimum requirements, and that was very exciting to me. It was the first time that I ever gave the idea some serious thought and emotional energy.

How do you think your experience at BSM prepared you to get you to where you are now?

The values emphasized by BSM were extremely important, especially the sense of community. The crew on the space station is pretty isolated, so we've all got to have the interpersonal skill not just to survive working and living with each other, but to actually enjoy it. Simple things, like being concerned about the well-being of one another, are very important. Also, team sports at BSM taught me a tremendous amount about how to work as a member of a team in stressful situations.

Was there anyone at BSM who was a particular influence?

There were so many positive influences that I'm sure to leave out some that I intended to include. One that I remember particularly well was Mr. Jim Wander. He was my Physics teacher as well as my track coach. His calm, encouraging demeanor is something that I appreciated. Also, our football coach from I believe the 1983 and 1984 seasons. He didn't only strive to develop a good football team, but also a group of good young men.

Do you have a favorite BSM memory that sticks out in your mind?

There are so many memories – the retreats, running around the lakes during track practice, pep rallies, and just hanging out with my friends. I remember doing a 100-mile bike ride with a group from BSM (maybe it wasn't really that far, that distance seems crazy far to me now), and it took us forever. One of my buddies had an odometer and was determined to get the full 100 miles done, so we just kept going and going. I think we were the last three to finish, and it was well after dark. We made that distance though, whatever it was supposed to be!

What do you hope to gain from your mission on the ISS?

What I really hope to give is a sense of gratitude for the incredible opportunity this is. Life on the ISS is challenging. My first few weeks adjusting to this sense of weightlessness felt like learning to walk all over again. We are always trying to keep up with a timeline of science and maintenance tasks, and until you get in the habit of handling everything in a way that will prevent it from floating away from where you expected it to be, your chances of success are slim.

However, it is an amazing opportunity to advance science for humanity, to gain a perspective of the Earth and our place on it that very few ever receive, and wow, the views are incredible! I've gained a great appreciation

for the fact that, relatively speaking, all of the people on Earth are much closer to what we call outer space than they might think. Imagine a place 15 miles away from where you are. Now, imagine that that same distance straight up would put you roughly 10 miles above Mt. Everest and able to see the blackness of space and the limits of the atmosphere. Of course, it takes a lot more energy to get up here than to travel the same distance horizontally, but from up here, 250 miles up, our atmosphere seems like a delicate thin veneer covering the Earth's surface.

Do you have any specific plans after your mission is complete?

Relaxing at home with my wife is the thing that I'm looking forward to most right now.

Is there any advice you'd like to share with current Red Knights as they plan for their futures?

Sure!

1. Figure out what it is that you love to do, and try to find a way to do it.
2. Try challenging things even if there is a chance that you'll fail. If you do fail, learn from the experience. If you still want to try to succeed in that endeavor, think about what you can do differently, and try again!
3. Always do your best, but put more emphasis on helping the others around you to be their best versus you having to be better than everyone else.

ATHLETIC Hall of Fame

The BSM Athletic Hall of Fame celebrated its fifth year of inductees on October 6. It is a wonderful community event honoring the outstanding athletic accomplishments and contributions to the athletic history and traditions of St. Margaret's Academy, Benilde High School, and Benilde-St. Margaret's.

John Jordan '67, one of the legendary Jordan brothers, definitely made his mark on Benilde athletics. There is great sports history in his family that centers around football and wrestling – beginning with his dad in the early 40s. Traveling from Hamel, John followed his older brother **Bob** to Benilde in 1963, and the stuff of legends was beginning. In the fall, John was on the football field where he earned honors as a tackle. When football was over John headed immediately to the wrestling mat. As a senior, team captain John was undefeated and he finished his career as a state champion. Coach Joranger admired his focus and intensity saying, “We hate to lose such a great man as John. He was a real inspiration to the whole team. He deserved every award he received.” John continued his education at St. Mary’s in Winona where he also wrestled. As a side note, John contributed regularly to the Benilde student newspaper, the Lancer, where he featured other student athletes in Knight’s Corner.

The stories were always about the Jordan brothers and the next brother was **Matt** '68. As co-captain of the football team, Matt was part of the offensive line that was labeled “vicious” by the Lancer. After collecting honors in football, Matt turned his attention to a very successful wrestling season as the team’s heavyweight, and then it was on to the track. Matt’s shot put record of 53’ 7 ½” was the longest standing Red Knight record. Just last year, senior **Eric Wilson** '17 broke that record with a put of 56’ 5”. Matt earned the WW “Pudge” Heffelfinger Memorial Scholarship to Yale where he continued his participation in football, wrestling and track. As a gridder he was All-Ivy, All-East Coast and All-American Honorable Mention. With a degree in biology, Matt moved back home and

earned his MD at the University of Minnesota Medical School and completed his residency and board certification at the University of North Dakota.

John Reger '70, gave football a try as a freshman, but soon settled on soccer, basketball and baseball as his sports of choice. In goal his junior year, John helped his team win the MISSL State Championship in soccer. The following year he moved from the net to offense and was the team’s leading scorer. He handled first base duties on the diamond, but his real love was basketball. Throughout his career on the court he received All-Conference, All-Tournament, and All-State honors. Tri-captain his senior year, he was a scoring machine for the Red Knights. He was one of the most electrifying players to play Red Knight basketball. He played with grace and flair, especially out in the open court. His passion and fearlessness enhanced the tradition of the Red Knight fast break. John headed west after graduation and continued his basketball and academic careers at Stanford. A singer/songwriter, TV and film actor, and journalist and news anchor, John currently lives in Springfield, Illinois.

Finishing first seemed to be **Mark Graham’s** '72 style and many of his accomplishments were based on numbers. Mark owned two Independent High School State Championships in cross country and in the spring, he earned two titles in the 2 mile. He was also the co-captain of the cross country and track teams. According to coach Ron Kretsch, he was definitely the dominant force among independent school runners. The eighth of nine Graham children, Mark was a humble and unassuming runner and a capable leader. Mark’s

team won the conference title in each of his four years, and they never finished below third at the state meet. In addition to all of his firsts in athletics, Mark was number 1 in his class and Benilde’s elected student council president. Mark continued his academic and running careers at Harvard University. He earned his medical degree at the Mayo Medical School and is currently the founder of and a physician at Waverly Hematology Oncology in Cary, North Carolina.

Elizabeth Winter Braun’s '95 Red Knight sports career was determined somewhat by injuries. She earned a varsity letter in soccer as a freshman but was forced to “retire” due to injury. She headed to cross country as a sophomore. Another injury led her to the pool as a junior. A varsity letter and most improved award accompanied that venture. As a senior, Liz was back to cross country. She was All-Conference and MVP in both sophomore and senior years. Captain of both cross country and track, Liz earned four letters in track and was a state participant all four years. In the 800, Liz was 5th at state as a sophomore and 3rd in the same race as a junior. Her relay teams still hold records in the sprint medley, the 4x800, and the 4x1600. As a Tommie, Liz ran cross country and indoor and outdoor track. She also earned All-Conference honors in cross country at DePauw University. Liz and her family currently live in Whitefish Bay, Wisconsin.

Nic Marx '99 came to BSM as a sophomore and immediately made an impact on the Red Knight athletic program. As a 10th grader he earned All-Conference honors in basketball. In his junior year he earned All-Conference and MVP distinction in basketball, the team won the

Missota Conference title, won the Catholic Spirit Tournament, and advanced to the finals of the section. He also added a varsity letter in baseball. Always known for his strong finishes, Nic began his senior year with All-Conference and most valuable offense honors in football. The success continued in basketball. The Red Knights won the Metro Alliance Conference title, he was named MVP and All-Conference, and was selected as a member of the All-Metro 3rd team. Nic is currently the fourth leading scorer in BSM basketball history. He closed out his senior year with All-Conference honors in baseball. Coach **John Moore** '74 noted, "His tenacity and leadership were exponentially responsible for the resurgence in BSM basketball." Nic continued his education and basketball career at the University of St. Thomas.

Mary Winter Reed '00 started her years with soccer and ended with track. Although Mary earned two varsity letters in soccer, her brilliant performances on the track are the most memorable. She was All-Conference all four years, MVP sophomore, junior and senior years, and captain as a 12th grader. In addition to section championships, Mary was a state participant all four years. Individually, she earned 8th and 9th place in the 200 and 2nd place in the 400. The 4x400 relay was 4th her freshman year and 3rd her senior year and she was a 9th grader on the 4x200 relay team that placed 8th. Mary still holds school records in the 100, the 400, and the 4x400 relay. As a track and field athlete at Columbia University, Mary was the team captain her junior and senior years. She was a qualifier and participant at the NCAA National Championships, earned ECAC All-East honors, and 2nd team All-Ivy. Before heading to Denver, where Mary and her family currently live, she coached with Jim Wander at BSM.

Colleen Powers '04 contributed to cross country, soccer, and hockey at BSM, but she made her real mark in softball. As team captain and talented shortstop, she collected numerous awards and headed to the University of Minnesota on a softball scholarship. As a Gopher, she was team captain, most valuable player, Blue Collar Award winner, Coach's Award winner, and three-time Academic All-Big 10. She finished her career with a perfect 1.000 fielding percentage. Following her playing career at Minnesota, Colleen helped coach the West Texas A & M University softball team to its first national ranking in program history. Coaching stints at Central Michigan and Lakeville South preceded her current role as head coach at St. Catherine University. Since taking over, the Wildcats have had a dramatic turnaround. She was named MIAC Coach-of-the-Year in 2016 and 2017 and earned NIFCA Midwest Regional Coaching Staff of the Year in 2017. Last year was the most successful season in program history at St. Kate's.

Kachine Alexander '07 was a key player on BSM's basketball team for four years, earning All-Conference honors each year. During her junior year the team claimed the State Championship and Kachine was named the state tournament MVP and was on the state All-Tournament team. Despite a season-ending injury her senior year, Kachine was selected to both the All-State First Team and the All-Metro Second Team and was a Miss Basketball finalist. She earned numerous honors at the University of Iowa including three-time All Big Ten star and two-time Big Ten All-Defensive Team pick. She was the first player in Big Ten women's basketball to record two triple-doubles in the same season. She was the first Hawkeye and the fifth in Big 10 history to record 1,000 career points, 800 career rebounds,

and 300 career assists. As a 5'9" guard, she was the top rebounding guard in the nation as a senior. She was a 3rd round draft pick by the Minnesota Lynx. Kachine is currently a Division 1 assistant coach.

Three-sport athlete **Adam Weisenburger** '07 earned at least one All-Conference award in each of his sports – soccer, hockey and baseball. Honored with All-Metro recognition for baseball – his favorite sport – he also earned a spot on the All-State Tournament Teams for both soccer and baseball. Adam was a senior on the BSM soccer team that earned a state title. A captain of the baseball team as a senior, Adam positioned himself behind the plate as a catcher for four varsity seasons. The young sophomore catcher was on the team that won two back-to-back games to advance to the state tournament where they placed third. It was the first trip to the state tournament for a BSM baseball team. Adam continued his baseball career at Miami University in Oxford, Ohio. He was a mainstay behind the plate for the Red Hawks and he led the club in on-base percentage. Adam was a team leader, serving as a captain both junior and senior year. He was drafted by the Milwaukee Brewers and played with their organization until 2017.






