When we asked that same group for volunteers to share a few words about why they chose to continue the BSM legacy in their own families, the response was even more astounding. We were flooded with story after story, quote after quote, about the lifelong connections, the outstanding educational experiences, memories, and many other gifts their time at BSM brought with it. Parents shared their belief in the school shaping them into the wonderful individuals they are today.

It became evident the blessing of a BSM education is just that – a blessing – and one many of our families felt imperative to pass along to the ones who mean the most to them. **All in. I'd say.**



"I have had two sons graduate from BSM and have three more kids now... so why BSM?"

My husband and I are strong believers in a faith-based education and my children are the fourth generation to attend Benilde-St. Margaret's - so it has also become a tradition that has worked well for my family over the last 80 years or so," said Nicole Shull Wolfe, a '91 grad.

"Those are the reasons why we started... We've stayed because our kids have been happy here, safe here, challenged here, held accountable here and have made friends while being taught by passionate educators. What more can a parent ask?"

Mike Keegan, '90, echoed many of those thoughts. "My wife and I wanted our kids to have an outstanding education, the same Catholic foundation we experienced, and extra-curricular opportunities to help set them up for success in whatever paths they choose after BSM," he said.

All in? Absolutely.

Adam Sellke '88 and his wife Mary Tremmel Sellke '88 both attended the school, and now have three children following in their footsteps.

"BSM has been our family's home away from home where we've connected, contributed, and grown. The community of caring that this school has fostered over the years has been an enduring example of the love we're all meant to show toward one another," Adam said.

Luke Toft '86 and his wife Frederique, a BSM French teacher, are current parents to two Red Knights.

"I had a great high school experience at BSM. I'm still very close to many friends from that time, and I wanted to give my kids the same opportunity," Luke said. He added his family is truly "all in," inspiring the headline of the story.

We also have several Red Knight community members who, in addition to serving as parent alums, are current BSM faculty and staff members. They include Dave Platt '85 and Megan Kern '86, who tied the knot in 1997,

I get to have some of the same teachers as them and they actually know me because of my family," said Alex Berggren, a BSM junior.

Sophie Coleman, a BSM sophomore, said her mother, Melissa Brandstetter Coleman '90, was one of seven who attended the school. Although an alumna herself, Melissa gave her daughter the choice between several schools. After Sophie experienced BSM first-hand, both she and her mother were **all in** instantaneously.

"After visiting with admissions, I knew I was home. I've been blessed to be a part of the BSM community. Now that I'm in my second year here, I'm convinced that coming here was the best decision I could have made," Sophie said. She also talked about the Red Knight basketball team treating her like family and welcoming her with open arms.

"Seeing a generation of my peers send their kids back here spoke volumes to me about legacy, tradition and passing down values," Melissa added.

That legacy, the traditions and those values can be seen in the hallways of BSM, at community events, and in the contagious energy that encompasses our school day in and day out.

ATHLETIC Hall of Fame

The BSM Athletic Hall of Fame celebrated its sixth year of inductees on September 28, 2018. It is a wonderful community event honoring the outstanding athletic accomplishments and contributions to the athletic history and traditions of St. Margaret's Academy, Benilde High School and Benilde-St. Margaret's.

Jerry Gilligan '71:

Jerry Gilligan was an accomplished and well-known athlete at Benilde. Not only did he make his mark here in the athletic department but his four sons (**Peter** '05, **Michael** '07, **Patrick** '09, **Thomas** '12) also brought that same degree of success to their careers at BSM. Gilligan began his careers as a three-sport athlete, but after two years of football, he decided it was best to concentrate and dedicate his time to hockey and golf, a wise choice in his career as he would go on to prove his skills in both sports during his career as a Red Knight. A solid defenseman on the ice, BSM Coach Fronczak noted that, "Gilligan is probably the most poised player on the team and he rarely loses control of the situation." That same poise contributed to his success on the links. After graduating from Benilde in 1971, Brown University was next on Gilligan's journey both academically and athletically as he continued his hockey career as a Brown Bear. According to Red Knight peers, in addition to his athletic prowess, Jerry had a presence about him that exuded calmness, class and leadership. This calmness and leadership set him up for success in his career after Brown, attending Villanova University School of Law where he graduated Magna Cum Laude and earned his JD.

Jim Urbanek '73:

For **Jim Urbanek**, being a three-sport athlete came naturally. As a Red Knight, he started his years on the gridiron, moved to the rink and finished on the track. Managing three seasons of sports is an impressive accomplishment in itself, but Urbanek was not short on successes as an athlete. He had a tenacity for each sport he participated in and it was evident through his work ethic he aimed to do better and always be better. According to the 1973 yearbook, life was a bit tough for the football team then but Jim was one of the bright spots. In fact, Urbanek scored a touchdown against Minneapolis South securing

the homecoming win for the Red Knights back in 1972. He was also one of only six seniors on the hockey team that was in a rebuilding phase. Jim's efforts on that team were described as "heroic." On the track, he captained the team and excelled in the longest sprint, the 440 dash. It should be no surprise to anyone that Jim was voted the best athlete by his classmates. After graduating from BSM, Urbanek earned a Bachelor of Science in business from the University of Minnesota and he is married to SMA graduate, **Rita Sheehan Urbanek** '73.

Pat Walter '75:

The first Benilde-St. Margaret's graduating class had great leadership on and off the field. Leading the class was **Pat Walter**, another strong three-sport athlete. Walter showcased his athletic capabilities beginning his years as a Red Knight on the football field. The first BSM yearbook gave much of the credit for the second straight winning football season to the co-captains, **Pat Walter** and **Tim Miller** '75. His skills on the field did not go unnoticed, and he was named to the All Central Catholic Conference team for his efforts on the field. In the gym, Walter demonstrated his persistent attack on the basketball team, giving strength to Coach Schwankl's squad. In the spring, sprinting was one of Walter's specialties on the track & field team. After 43 years, Walter's name is still on the record board in the Haben Center. He was known as a leader throughout his athletic career at Benilde and BSM and he had a lasting impact on his teammates during his years as a Red Knight. Possibly the ultimate compliment came from a teammate who said, "He was a great leader, an even better teammate, and a great person on and off the field, court or track." He continued his leadership roles at Regis College as the Student-Body President and a student representative on the Board of Trustees. He excelled academically, graduating Magna Cum Laude.

Tom Kosel:

Although this honoree is not an alum, **Tom Kosel** was a pioneer for athletic programs for young women at St. Margaret's Academy and Benilde-St. Margaret's. He laid the groundwork for scores of Red Knight ladies to experience extracurricular athletics. In the early 70s, he started the athletic program at SMA with volleyball and basketball. He then went on and added cross country and track to the mix, helping start the first Twin Cities conference for girls. Those early teams won multiple conference and state titles, and many individual athletes and teams participated at the state level. The basketball team from 1976 went 20-1 before losing to St. Paul Central in the finals of the first Minnesota State High School League state tournament for girls. After his career at Benilde-St. Margaret's, Kosel moved to the College of St. Thomas where he was the very successful head coach of the women's basketball team for seven seasons. According to one of his players, "Coach Kosel taught us many life lessons in the classroom, in the gym and on the track. He helped us to understand that we were part of something much larger and more important than just ourselves." After leaving BSM in 1976 and continuing his coaching career at CST, Kosel's passion for education never faded. His career took him to various institutions including Herzing College as the campus president and Globe University as the director of government and community relations.

Molly Cashman Sebold '76:

Molly Cashman Sebold was lucky enough to have Athletic Hall of Fame inductee Tom Kosel as her coach, and was one of the players on the team that finished 2nd (by two points) in the first Minnesota State High School League tournament for girls. Sebold sampled a few sports in her high school career, including volleyball, cross country, basketball and softball. Although she settled on cross country and softball in the "off seasons," her real love was basketball. She was the captain

of her basketball team that was undefeated until that final state tournament game against St. Paul Central. The irony of course was that the Red Knights had defeated that same team earlier in the season by two points. According to all reports, Molly's fast break points were often the difference for the team. Molly continued her career on the court at the University of Notre Dame. She was a two-time captain for the Irish and the MVP her senior year. Not only was she able to lead the Irish women's basketball team, but she also excelled academically, graduating with High Honors. She also earned her MBA, graduating with honors in graduate school from the University of Minnesota Carlson School of Business.

John Lundeen '78:

John Lundeen, better known as Johnno to those who knew the star athlete in the 70s, collected major honors in his three sports: football, basketball and baseball. A three-sport athlete and a three-sport captain, Lundeen earned all-conference and MVP honors in each. After graduating from Benilde-St. Margaret's, he attended Normandale Community College where he carried on his athletic career playing basketball and baseball. As a first baseman hitting .500, he was a member of the first Minnesota team to compete in the Junior College World Series. He continued his winning ways at the University of Minnesota where he was part of a Big 10 Championship baseball team. Lundeen played amateur baseball for 16 years and in 2013 was inducted into the Minnesota Class A Amateur Hall of Fame. In addition to playing, John shared his knowledge and love of sports, coaching baseball and basketball at BSM, DeLaSalle, Totino Grace and St. Anne's, including having the privilege of coaching retired professional basketball player and BSM graduate, **Devean George '95**. It was difficult to name a sport that Lundeen did not excel at, both as an athlete and coach. Those that know him not only speak to Lundeen's dedication and skills as an athlete, but also about his kindness, his humble persona and huge heart.

Jillian Zebeck '00:

Jillian Zebeck was most often found in the pool. Zebeck is an accomplished swimmer, beginning her Red Knight swimming career in the junior high. She was small but mighty in junior high and grew in stature and accomplishments throughout her years at BSM. She was dominant in the backstroke and won two state championships in that event. In addition, in her junior year she helped her team capture 3rd place at the Minnesota state swim meet. Following her graduation from BSM, Zebeck attended Rutgers University on a four-year athletic scholarship. As a Scarlet Knight, she set records in the 100 and 200 backstroke, and

was part of record-setting medley relays in the 200 and 400. It's not hard to guess which leg of the relay was Jillian's. A leader in and out of the pool, Jillian was captain of the BSM Red Knights and the Rutgers University Scarlet Knights. She graduated with two Bachelor of Arts degrees in communication and sociology from Rutgers. After graduating as a Scarlet Knight, Zebeck attended graduate school at Quinnipiac University earning a Masters in Science Information Communication.

Stevi Seitz Evans '04:

Three-sport letter winner **Stevi Seitz Evans** made a name for herself in high school and college. As a soccer, basketball and track star in high school, she collected numerous all-conference and team awards in each sport. In her senior year as a Red Knight, her three teams were conference champs – soccer, basketball and track. Additionally, as a senior, Evans earned a spot on

of the list of accolades. Moving to neighboring Wisconsin, Taylor had a storied career as a Badger. One of 11 finalists for the Bob Cousy Award, given to the nation's top point guard, Taylor earned All-American honors, led the Badgers to a Sweet 16 appearance and set an NCAA record for assists-to-turnovers. According to Coach Moore, one of the most memorable moments in Jordan's career included the 2008 State Tournament quarter-final game vs. St. Paul Como Park. The Red Knights were up by three at the half but in the locker room, Moore implored the team to "step it up" because losing the lead would give the veteran coach of the Cougars the opportunity to do things offensively that the Red Knights had never seen. Como Park got the ball at the beginning of the 2nd half but missed a shot. Coach Moore got up to call a play and Taylor put his hand up and stopped him mid-sentence, saying, "I got it coach." As John Moore said, in previous years he would have called a timeout, taken Taylor out of the game and had a

the All-State 1st team in soccer. In basketball, she tops the list of BSM scorers with 1,492 career points. In track, she is still on the record board for the 3x300 hurdles. After graduating from Benilde-St. Margaret's in 2004, she continued her basketball career with a full-ride scholarship to Idaho State University. As a Bengal, Stevi earned 1st team all-conference honors twice, was a pre-season player of the year, and won back-to-back conference titles her sophomore and junior years. After her time as an Idaho State University Bengal, graduating with a BA in elementary education, Evans went on to receive her Masters from the University of St. Thomas. She has since pursued a career in education, teaching 5th graders at Good Shepherd.

Jordan Taylor '08:

Jordan Taylor, Mr. Basketball 2008, has a litany of honors in high school and college. All-Conference, All-State, MVP and State Champion are all part

heart-to-heart discussion. Instead he sat down, told his assistant coach, "This should be interesting," and proceeded to watch Taylor go off for 26 points in the 2nd half and 42 for the game. Two days later, the Red Knights were State Champs. It is evident that Taylor always earned the trust and faith of his coaches and teammates. He was an exceptional leader, very charismatic and – he hated to lose more than he liked to win. He embodied the mantra "refuse to lose."

BSM ALUMNI MAKING A DIFFERENCE

Sean Cox '04

Regional Agricultural Attaché for Department of Agriculture at U.S. Embassy in Guatemala

At the core of Benilde-St. Margaret's mission as a Catholic school is our long-held tradition of service. For Benilde-St. Margaret's 2004 graduate Sean Cox, this unique type of service-learning experience instilled his passion to serve others. "BSM gave me that first experience doing community development work and working with underserved communities," Sean said.

While at BSM, Sean had the opportunity to travel outside of the U.S., including a life-changing trip to Costa Rica. Sean said it was an eye-opening experience for him. Little by little, Sean continued to volunteer around the world, coming full circle to what he does now.

Sean is currently the Regional Agricultural Attaché for the Department of Agriculture based at the United States Embassy in Guatemala City. Prior to landing his current position, Sean served in the Peace Corps where he volunteered in El Salvador. He also received two master's degrees in economics and international development from Fordham University, and he briefly worked for the United Nations.

Now at the United States Department of Agriculture, he has the opportunity to do what he loves, serving others and making a difference. The generic definition of Sean's job is ensuring U.S. agricultural exports can access remote places like Guatemala, El Salvador and Honduras. However, the main project he oversees is food aid and development work with school meal programs.

Guatemala is the largest school meals program in the world for the U.S. government, providing school meals to 132,000 students and nearly a thousand schools a day. "We work very hard to provide these meals for students here because Guatemala has a huge issue with malnutrition, with childhood stunting, as well as issues with literacy and education," Sean said.

The most rewarding part for Sean is seeing the hard work that goes into these programs that make an impact. "It's amazing to have the little moments meeting with the parents and families that are actually benefiting from these programs. I have also had the amazing opportunity taking high-level officials from the US government to see the programs, showing them that the impact they're having on the ground is real."

Since graduating from BSM, Sean's passion has been working in international development and public service. His advice for current Red Knight students is to explore the opportunities presented to you.

"Take advantage of all the opportunities that you're offered. There are some things at the time you do for fun, but you don't really realize how they're going to shape your future. Explore different opportunities because you never know where it will take you," he said.

Dolly Steichen Lowery '83

Co-Founder of Kinuu, Puts Hopes in Motion

Dolly Steichen Lowery, a 1983 BSM graduate, has the important role of playing mom to two boys, one of whom has a severe learning disability.

After ten years in clinics and more than 1,200 visits with him, she felt she had heard and seen it all.

"I was in a clinic one day with him and there was a mom there who had quad boys with Autism. She could only afford to bring one because her insurance would only cover one child," she said.

Even with great health insurance that Dolly and her family had, the exercises and clinic homework her son was receiving once a week was just not enough.

Dolly wanted more for her family, more for her child, and more for her child's future.

After 17 years in software sales, Dolly realized she was being called to venture down a different career path.

With a background in technology and software, Dolly was inspired to take action - starting her own company, Kinuu, to help children with ADD/HD, Dyslexia, and Autism develop socially and academically.

With the help of a handful of specialists, Dolly and her team developed the Xbox style video game "BrainyAct" to help kids with ADD/HD, Dyslexia and Autism. The idea was to create a software program that brings real change to our youth. The game is interactive, which makes it unique to each child, and uses game-changing technology with proven clinical therapies, for effective results. Dolly started Kinuu knowing there had to be something better out there for kids who were not flourishing in various developmental areas.

After months of testing pilot programs in Minnesota (SunnyDays OT Clinic), New York (Mount Sinai Hospital) and Illinois (Guiding Light Academy), Dolly and her team launched commercially in May 2018. Dolly and her

team invited more than 100 families to participate in "Planet BrainyAct," a highly-specialized program in which families have an extra layer of support with BrainyAct coaches on hand to help children effectively play the game. Planet BrainyAct, based in Minnetonka, continues to serve as a safe and fun environment where families can play the game and see results.

Although Dolly never intended on working with kids with learning disabilities, it is now her passion and her company's goal to "put hope in motion." Her company's three main goals include affordability, effectiveness and making treatment for these families convenient. "We each individually believe wholeheartedly that our programs can help unlock the potential within these children," Dolly explained when talking about what motivates her.

In addition to starting a company assisting kids with learning disabilities, she also founded Gilda's Club Twin Cities, a non-profit home for families dealing with cancer. She started the club after losing two siblings to brain tumors. Dolly is one of five siblings to have graduated from BSM, stating, "BSM did a really good job of building the foundation of not being afraid to serve. They help build a fearlessness that leadership is important and encourages you to find something you're passionate about."

In an interview Dolly gave to Fox 9, she explained the vision behind her company, "The vision was twofold: to help families in the home, to help moms that are frustrated and hopeless, and to build collective data that can help fuel research for the next generation."

Dolly's day to day is always different, but what remains true is her dedication to helping others, "We do have a ways to go but the number one goal was always effectiveness for these children, and to see actual changes." It's safe to say Dolly and her team have reached that goal.

Dylan Hoen '18 qualified for the Minnesota Junior PGA Championships this past summer.

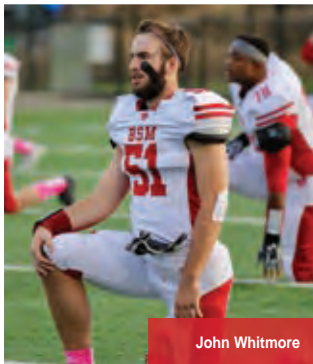
John Whitmore '19 was listed as part of the Star Tribune preseason metro dream team defense, commending his passion for the game and noting he "plays with grit."

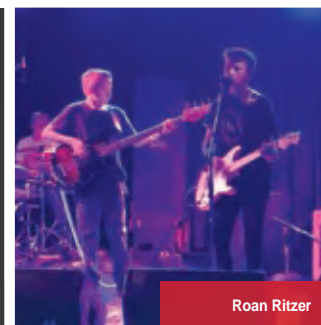
BSM was awarded 1st Place in this year's Twin Cities' Best of Business Awards in the Education, Private School category by Twin Cities Business magazine.

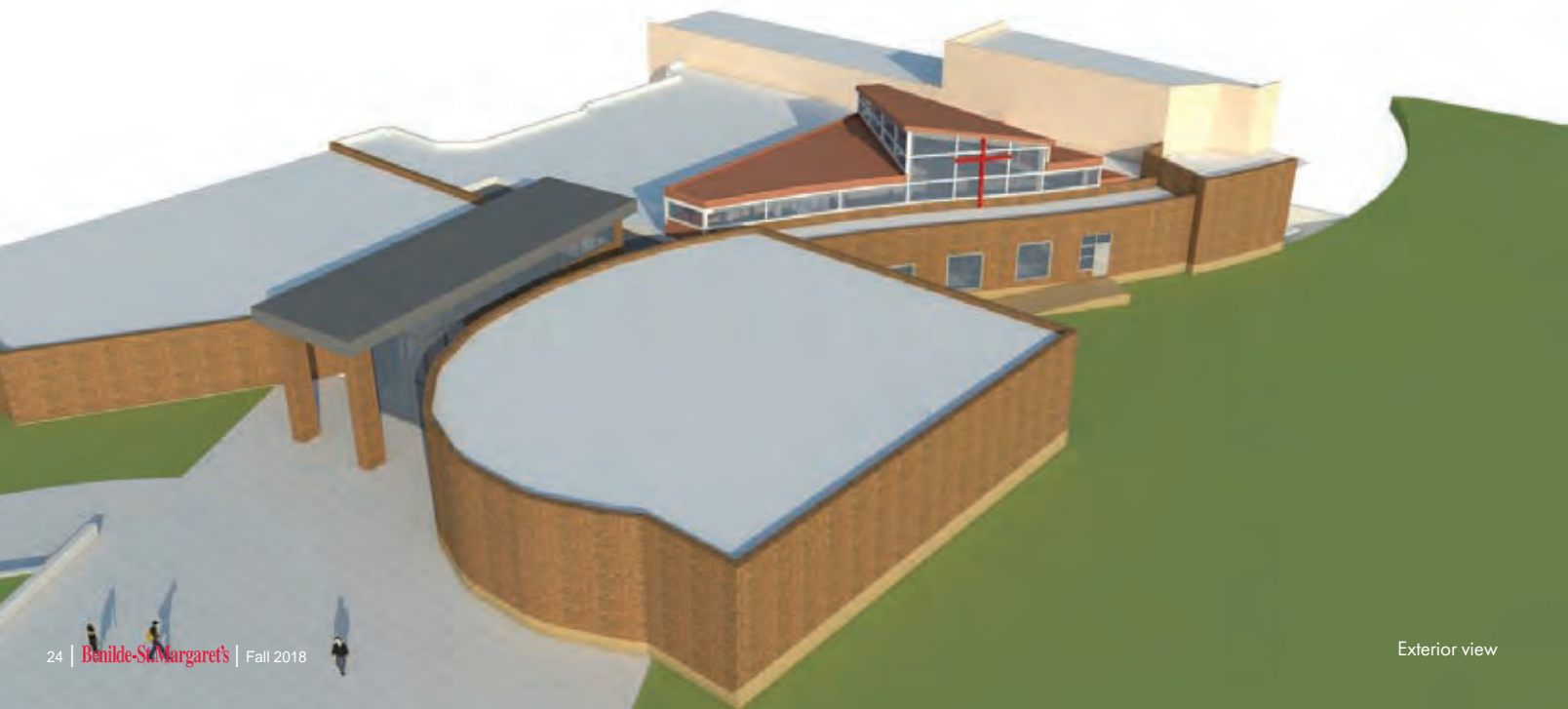

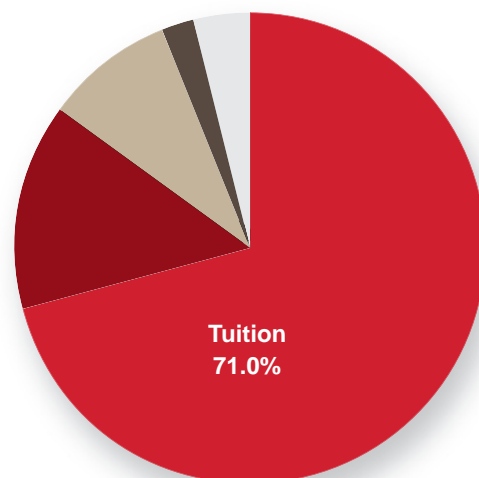

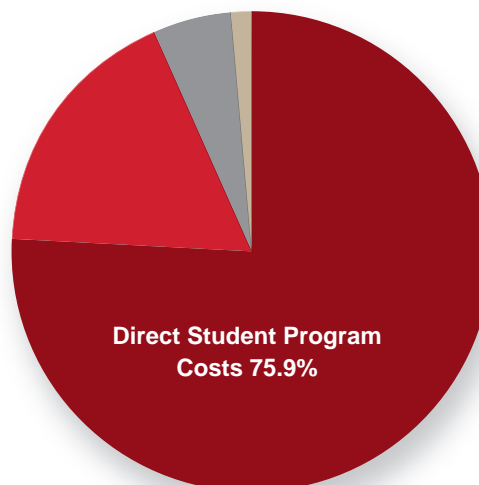
