



## Transportation Charges 22-23

***The District will pay the transportation costs for the following in-state trips:***

- **Grade level field trips** - one trip per grade level for the following:
  - Elementary sites - 2nd and 4th grade
  - Intermediate sites - 6th grade
  - Middle Schools - 8th grade
  - High School - 10th and 12th grade
- **Clubs / Organizations** - One trip per club for the following: a performance, presentation, competition, student recognition ceremony, or have educational value and may only be taken at the principal's discretion.
- **Transition Trips** from one school level to the next (ex. elementary students to intermediate schools at the end of the year to tour building and prepare students for transition)
- **Special Education** competitions and/or field trips for life-skills training
- **Fine Arts**
  - that rehearse / perform at another site or a local community facility due to limited space at their home site, limited space at the PAC or HS auditorium.
  - competing in competitions that reinforce Oklahoma Academic Standards.
  - Elementary - Two trips per semester per school site (principals choose grade level(s))
  - IS and MS - Three trips per semester per school site (Choir / Band / Theater)
- **Athletics** - OSSAA published competitions; Sanctioned events; district approved summer activities; excludes trips where students are NOT transported (ex. coaches clinics, scouting trips)
- **OSSAA Activities** or competition for students competing in OSSAA events; Band, Choir, Theater.
- **Required Field Trips** - these are trips that are required in order for a club/organization to maintain it's membership/status (ex. DECA Conference- this is required in order for MPS to continue to have a DECA program)
- **ROTC** - Color Guard trips will be covered by the district.

### **Board approval is required on any of the following:**

- Overnight trips
- Out-of-state trips (*transportation charges will not be covered by the district for out of state trips*)

### **Disclaimer:**

- Additional trip(s) will be considered when students have earned the opportunity to compete or perform at the state level.
- Additional trip(s) will be considered by district administration as requested.

### **Charges:**

- As long as the trip meets the criteria listed on this document you will put "0" in the PO box when reserving a bus.
- Yellow buses/activity buses - charge \$2 per mile and \$16.00 per hour for a driver.
- Suburban (Students) / Van (No Students) - charge \$2 per mile and provide your own driver.
