This is a 10-month internship with an anticipated start date of early August 2022.

- Serve as a liaison to other campus partners for academic support.
- Meet with student-athletes referred for additional academic or personal support.
- Enhance department communication for academic reports/graders.
- Assist with planning, executing and evaluating alumni, donor, sponsor and partner events
- Lead the development and promotion of new "W Club" arm of the Bulldog Club for former letter winners.
- Contribute to all student-athlete enhancement programs.
