FACILITIES SURVEY SUMMARY

Stoughton Area School District

THANK YOU to everyone who participated in the facilities survey that was conducted in May 2022. Your input will help inform the Board of Education as it continues to discuss the size and scope of a potential facilities referendum.



The following are highlights of the survey results provided by School Perceptions, an independent research firm.

SURVEY RESULTS

- · Over 1,560 community members responded to the survey, which is an above average response rate
- · 68% of respondents would recommend the District to a friend or family member
- Respondents showed **strong support for the base plan**, addressing the highest priority needs across the District
- · Respondents indicated updating or replacing Kegonsa Elementary was a priority
- · Respondents shared mixed support for additional projects tested in the survey
- · Respondents were supportive of investing in green buildings and renewable energy

FUNDING SUPPORT

When tabulating weighted support of Stoughton Area School District residents:

- · 65% support a \$36 million referendum to address the highest priority needs
- · Respondents may support a referendum up to \$50 million to include additional projects

Mixed support for additional projects suggests the District consider multiple phases of facilities work as part of our long-range master plan.

Support for additional projects is dependent on total funding and may include:

- · Replacing the Community Gym
- · Updating or replacing Kegonsa Elementary
- Updating and renovating Fox Prairie Elementary
- Creating a dedicated gym and cafeteria at Fox Prairie Elementary
- · Exploring options for the 1892 building
