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MUSICAL INSTRUMENTS

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The Board of Education will purchase and maintain a supply of musical instruments for pupils enrolled in the instrumental music program.

The music department allows pupils to take a school-owned instrument home to practice if the pupil wants to play an instrument and is unable to rent an instrument. There is a small inventory of instruments in each school to supplement pupil-owned instruments. If the pupil wants to play a very large instrument, it is furnished by the music department i.e., tubas, large percussion, basses, and baritone saxes. We do not charge students for a loaner. Music teachers keep record of instruments that are loaned to pupils and ask for their return at the end of the school year.

When music teachers request that pupils play more than one instrument, we loan available instruments to pupils. Accurate records are kept of such loans. If pupils wish to rent an instrument, we advise them of local companies.
