

OUR FAITH

Our Campus Ministry program provides opportunities for worship, servant leadership, and spiritual growth for all students. Campus Ministry isn't just a class - it's a campus-wide experience!

School-Wide Mass

We come together as a school every Thursday (or on Holy Days of Obligation) at 9:15am in the JCCHS gym. Families and guests are welcome!

Adoration & Confession

Students spend their Theology class praying and reflecting in the presence of The Blessed Sacrament in our chapel on the first Friday of every month, with the Sacrament of Reconciliation available all day.

Daily Prayer

In addition to prayer before classes, practices, games, shows, meetings, and concerts; our community begins and ends every day in prayer before the morning announcements.

Student-Led Retreats

Every grade-level has their own off-campus retreat day. Students can also opt-in to attending one of our 3 off-campus, overnight retreats: Metanoia (underclassmen, winter) or Kairos (upperclassmen, spring & fall).

Service

All students must meet our service hour requirements each year, with year-round on-campus and off-campus service opportunities.
