SUSPENSION OF EMPLOYEES

3148 SUSPENSION OF EMPLOYEES

The Superintendent may suspend with pay any Board of Education employee whenever such action appears necessary in the best interest of the proper functioning of the school system. If the affected employee is an Administrator or teaching staff member, the Superintendent must obtain the Board President's approval prior to the suspension.

The Superintendent shall forthwith report any suspension to the Board, which, in the case of the suspension of an Administrator or teaching staff member, shall by a recorded roll call majority vote of its membership take such action for the restoration or removal of such person as it deems proper, subject to requirements of law.

The Board may suspend a tenured employee with or without pay upon certification of tenure charges against the employee to the Commissioner of Education, or if the employee has been indicated.
