

Regular School Board Meetings

All regular School Board meetings will be held on the second Monday of each month, unless otherwise designated at the annual organizational meeting of the Board. The time and place for all regular meetings will be set at the organizational meeting. Public Notice shall be given by posting the proposed agenda in the Business Office at least twenty-four hours prior to the meeting.

All meetings of the School Board are open to the public; however participation by the public in meetings is not permitted except during those parts of the meeting where it is scheduled as a part of the approved agenda or by approval of a majority of the Board members. If a person wishes to present a matter for consideration by the Board, at a meeting of the Board, he/she must obtain permission from the Board President at that meeting.

The Board's business will be transacted in the order similar to that outlined below:

- Approve the Agenda
- Consent Agenda
- Minutes, Payment of Bills, Financial Report
- Reports
- Action on Bids
- Items of Old and New Business in order of Significance
- Executive Session
- Calendar of events and Future Business
