

**School Attorney**

The Board may appoint an attorney at its discretion to advise and represent the district.

It will be the duty of the School Attorney to advise the Board, Superintendent, and principal on the specific legal problems submitted to him/her. He/she will attend meetings upon request and will be sufficiently familiar with Board policies, practices, and actions under these policies and requirements of the school code of the state to enable him/her to offer the necessary legal advice.
