

School Year/School Calendar

A committee of Bon Homme Education Association (BHEA) members and Bon Homme School Board members shall meet for the purpose of discussing the upcoming school calendar. Either part may request in writing of the other the opening of discussions.

The school calendar for the ensuing year will be prepared by the superintendent and submitted to the Board for approval prior to July 1 of each year. The school calendar will meet or exceed the minimum number of instructional days required by Law.

No school will be held on Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and the Friday following Thanksgiving, Christmas Day, New Year's Day and the days between Christmas and New Year's, Good Friday, Memorial Day, Independence Day, and days when school is closed due to inclement weather or contagious disease and any other days set by the School Board each year.

Days missed for any reason may be made up at the end of the school year or sometime during the second semester (subject to negotiations) unless more than 10 days are missed for inclement weather in any one year. In that event, only ten days will be made up and the school term will be shortened. The first and second semesters will be scheduled to be as near equal in length as possible.
