

Contingency Plan for Handicapped Accessibility

Bon Homme School District recognizes that all students are entitled to an appropriate education. When a physical barrier stands in the way of that education, the district is committed to the removal of the barrier or to make other accommodations that may be necessary to help the student overcome the barrier. This policy sets forth the district plan for dealing with such situations.

GRADES K-5 All Bon Homme community elementary schools are handicap accessible.

GRADES 6-12 The District middle school/high school is a multi-level building. Building modifications exist to provide accessibility to each building level.

ALL GRADES Students who have vision or hearing handicaps whose placement committee finds attendance in the district appropriate will be provided with such modifications, assistance, or equipment called for in the Individual Education Plan.

Students, staff, or visitors unable to use the stairs, and are on upper floor levels during an emergency evacuation, will be directed by staff to the north stairwell, if available; if unavailable, south stairwell will be used. Staff will immediately notify the first responders of the location of the individual(s) in need of assistance.
