

Graffiti

It is the policy of Bon Homme School District that graffiti will not be permitted. Graffiti means any unwanted or disruptive writing, printing, marks, signs, symbols, figures, designs, inscriptions, or other drawings which are scratched, scrawled, painted, drawn, or otherwise placed on any exterior surface of a building, wall, fence, sidewalk, curb, desk, chair, blackboard, marker-board, or other item or structure on public or private property. Graffiti may also be found on an individual's exposed body, clothing, or belongings.

Any student, employee, or individual who intentionally places unwanted graffiti on any surface located on public or private property shall face disciplinary action which may include suspension of a student by the principal of up to 10 school days, suspension of a student by the Superintendent of up to 90 school days, or suspension or expulsion of the student by action of the Bon Homme School Board for the entire school year. Any employee who intentionally places unwanted graffiti on any surface may be suspended or terminated from employment. Any individual who intentionally places unwanted graffiti on any surface may be reported to local or State Law Enforcement Agencies or the State Attorney's Office for possible punishment.

Any person who is guilty of intentionally placing unwanted graffiti on any surface shall make restitution to the injury property for the cost of all repairs.
