

Publication or Creation of Materials

Under South Dakota Law, the school district may have legal claim on all products created by its employees which in any way may be an outgrowth of their job responsibility. In order to minimize misunderstandings about the ownership of such products, the Superintendent will effect procedures to be followed by all persons who are or might be developing commercially attractive products which are or might be construed to be associated with their normal job responsibility.
