3. **Air Brakes (Ch. # 5)**
4. **Passenger (Ch. # 4)**
5. **School Bus (Ch. # 10)**

Step 3 Print and fill out forms CDL-1 and CDL-10 from DPS site.
Bring Forms with you to DPS

Step 4 Once all tests are completed you have your COMMERCIAL LEARNERS PERMIT

Once you are hired you can expect the following training schedule:

Step 6 Training Curriculum (35 -40 hours)

1. Theory Training
2. Range Training
3. Behind the Wheel

DPS ROAD TEST = 2 hours

PHASE 1: PRE-TRIP = 45 minutes

1. Entire Bus inside & outside

2. Under the Bus & Engine Compartment
3. Light Test
4. Air Brake Procedures

PHASE 2: SKILLS = 25 minutes

1. Parallel Parking
2. Off Set
3. Straight Backing

PHASE 3: ROAD TEST with a DPS Personnel = 50 minutes

1. Loading & Unloading
2. Railroad Crossing
3. Emergency Pullover

Step 6 CERTIFICATION CLASS

1. The **20 hours** course will be done once you get your License. Certification Class is District paid. Your class date will be setup prior to training. **Select the transfer button to clock in and out.**
