A Two-Year Program Leading to the A.S. Degree

General Studies ASCT 2250 is designed for early college students who may change their educational goal after transitioning to 4-year institution, without meeting program specific requirements at Vincennes University. The degree is made up of a combination of 100 and 200 level courses which best serve students' needs or interests. An additional 15 hours of 200-level elective courses are required for the program. Students must successfully complete at least one writing reading and speaking intensive (WRSI) course. Courses chosen may not be on Indiana Core Transfer Library. A Certificate of Graduation

The Statewide Transfer General Education Core (STGEC) Certificate of Graduation is designed for students who are exploring program/major options in order to complete a degree at Vincennes University and for students who plan to transfer from VU to complete a degree elsewhere.

The STGEC allows students to identify their aptitudes and build an academic foundation that serves as the “first year” of course work for a range of degree programs at Vincennes University, including associate and baccalaureate degrees. The STGEC gives students the opportunity to prepare academically and socially for college success in order to compete in a global workplace. Successful completion of the STGEC will be recognized for transfer to public institutions of higher education in Indiana, in compliance with Senate Enrollment Act 182 (2012).
