# 2021 School Corporation Annual Performance Report (APR)

## General Explanations

### Goals for Expenditure Categories

#### **Southern Hancock/ Expenditure Goals**

1. For the 2021 fiscal year, the Community School Corporation School Corporation of Southern Hancock County shall maintain and strive to improve the current level of expenditures for the Educational Fund.
2. The Southern Hancock School Corporation shall strive to lower the percentage of transfers between the Educational Fund and the Operations Fund, trying to meet the 15% threshold.
3. The Corporation shall strive to assure that revenue exceeds expenditures for 2021.

Increases in the student instructional expenditure categories may not be possible due to the following unique circumstances.

1. The Southern Hancock School Corporation's past construction has created additional debt obligation that has increased the debt service expenditure category at a faster rate than the student instructional expenditure categories.
