1. We have adopted the Mike Holt electrical education series “Capacitor” system for all modules. This will provide you with both textbooks and the online digital series enabling students to access these materials at any time.
2. A copy of the 2020 NEC Code Book for the Fall 2022 modules. Since the 2023 NEC Code Book will be update as of January 1, 2023 you will be required to purchase the new code book for the spring module.
