Our History

The Warrior Run community as we know it today began to form over 250 years ago. Soon after, Watsontown and then Turbotville came into existence. The Warrior Run School District (WRSD) was formed in 1955 when the area had 2 high schools and 8 elementary schools. The current middle school opened in 1959 as the WRSD Jr/Sr High School and has served the WRSD for over 60 years. Since then, through the leadership of the school board, the WRSD has created a sound educational experience for the children of our district.

2022 represents the most significant year in the WRSD since that beginning. In 2022-23 the new elementary school, athletic fields, renovated athletic stadium, and field house will come on line. This centralized campus will now serve the people and students of WR well beyond the celebration of the first century of the WRSD.
