MBU Student Eligibility

HS students may elect to register for up to 18 advanced college credits per semester. Students are encouraged to seek counsel and guidance in choosing dual-credit courses.

In order to be eligible for dual credit courses, participating students are required to be in full compliance with the MDHE - Missouri Department of Higher Education following requirements:

- a) Students in the 11th and 12th grades must have an overall minimum cumulative grade point average of 80% are automatically eligible for dual credit courses.
- b) Students in the 11th and 12th grades with an overall cumulative grade point average between 75% - 80% must provide a signed letter of recommendation from their principal or guidance counselor and provide written permission from a parent or legal guardian.
- c) Students in the 10th grade must have an overall minimum cumulative grade point average of 80% and must provide a signed letter of recommendation from their principal and guidance counselor and provide written permission from a parent or legal guardian.
- d) Students in the 9th grade must have an overall minimum cumulative grade point average of 80% and score at the 90th percentile or above on the ACT or SAT and provide a signed letter of recommendation from their principal and guidance counselor and provide written permission from a parent or legal guardian.
