Notice is hereby given that affidavits of candidacy may be filed in the office of the city clerk, located at **St. Louis Park City Hall, 5005 Minnetonka Boulevard**, for the following school district elective offices:

- School Board Member (1 seat) – term expiring 2023**
- School Board Member (1 seat) – term expiring 2025**

Election date:

The election for these school district elective offices will be held on:

General Election: Tuesday, November 8, 2022

Candidate filing period:

The candidate filing period for these school district elective offices is as follows:

- Begins:** Tuesday, August 2, 2022 - 8:00 a.m.
- Closes:** Tuesday, August 16, 2022 - 5:00 p.m.

How to file for office:

To file for office you must:

- Complete an affidavit of candidacy
- Pay a \$2.00 filing fee

Qualifications for office:

The candidate for this office must be an eligible voter, must be 21 years of age or older on assuming office, must have been a resident of the school district from which the candidate seeks election for at least thirty (30) days before the general election, and must have no other affidavit on file for any other office at the same primary or general election.

Where to file for office:

Candidates filing for office should do so at St. Louis Park City Hall, 5005 Minnetonka Boulevard

The above requirements for filing must all be completed during the specified filing period, August 2, 2022 – August 16, 2022.
