Re: Commuter Benefits Available to San Mateo-Foster City School District Employees

In compliance with Senate Bill 1339, which was signed into law in 2012, the San Mateo-Foster City School District offers Commuter Benefits to all interested employees.

The District allows employees to claim commuter expenses, to and from work, through our Section 132(f) plan on a pre-tax basis.

Expenses under Sections 132(f) are as follows:

- Mass Transit (i.e. BART, Muni bus and rail, Caltrain, AC Transit, etc.) – Maximum \$280.00 per month
- Parking – Maximum \$280 per month

The District contracted with My Commuter Check to provide you the tax-free commuter benefits program. The amount you ordered will be deducted from your current pay check as pre-tax expenses. In addition, there is a \$3 handling fee per month only for the month that you participate in the program. The \$3 is not a pre-tax expense
