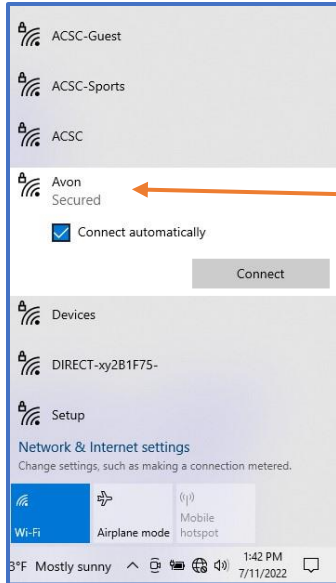
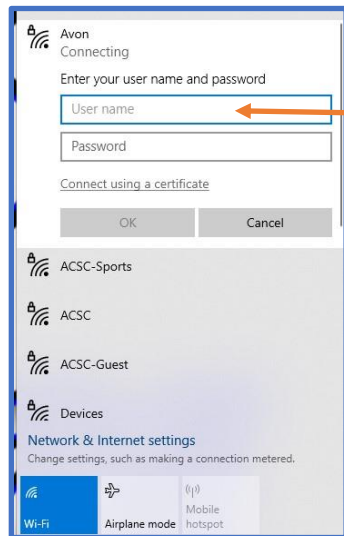


## BYOD – Connect to Avon Wi-Fi – Directions for Windows PC

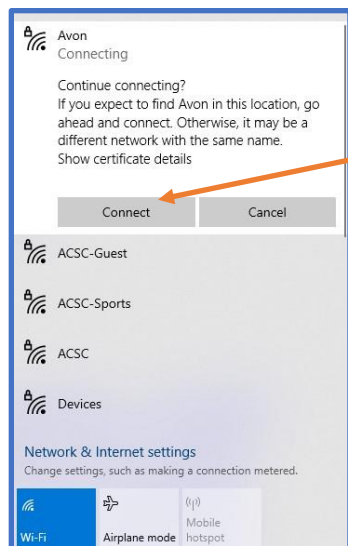


Select **Avon** from the available Wi-Fi SSIDs and click **Connect**.

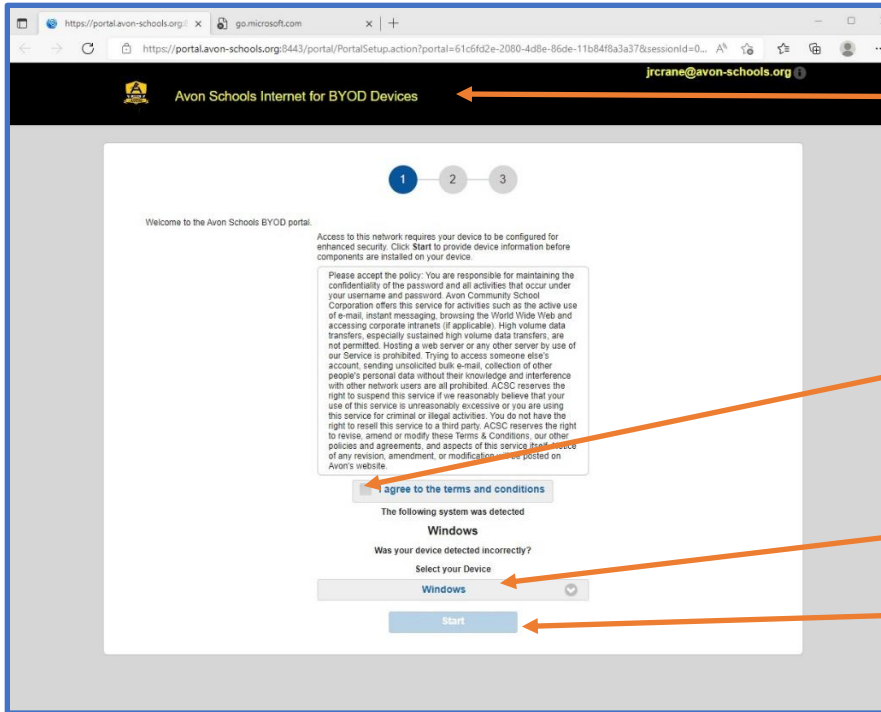


Enter your student id and password that you use for school computer systems.

If you have never signed into a school computer (e.g., New Student), please sign into a school owned device before trying to connect.



When asked if you want to continue connecting, click **Connect**.

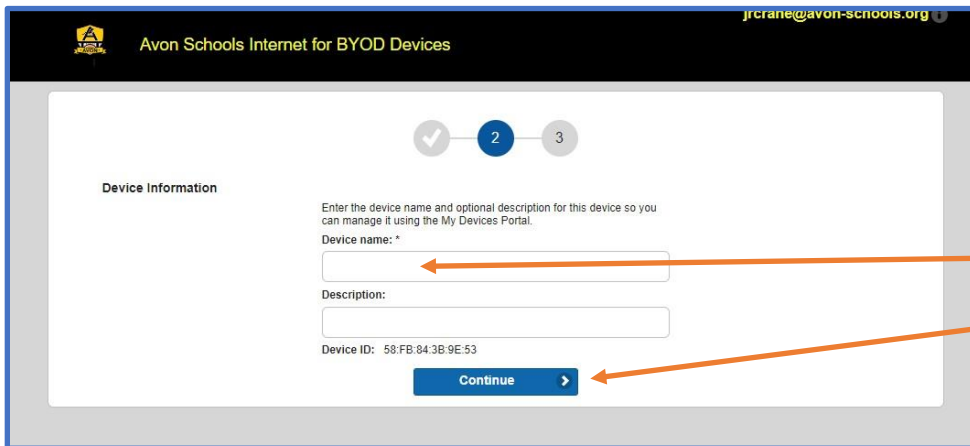


A browser window should open automatically and take you to the Avon Schools BYOD portal. If it does not, open your browser and try going to a website like cnn.com.

Once the BYOD screen opens up, check the box to agree to the terms and conditions.

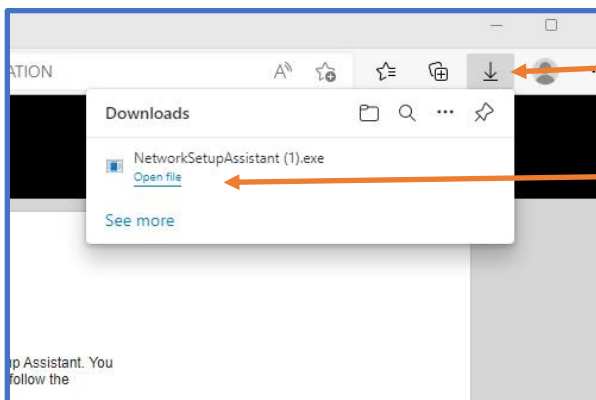
Make sure the correct operating system is listed.

Click **Start**.

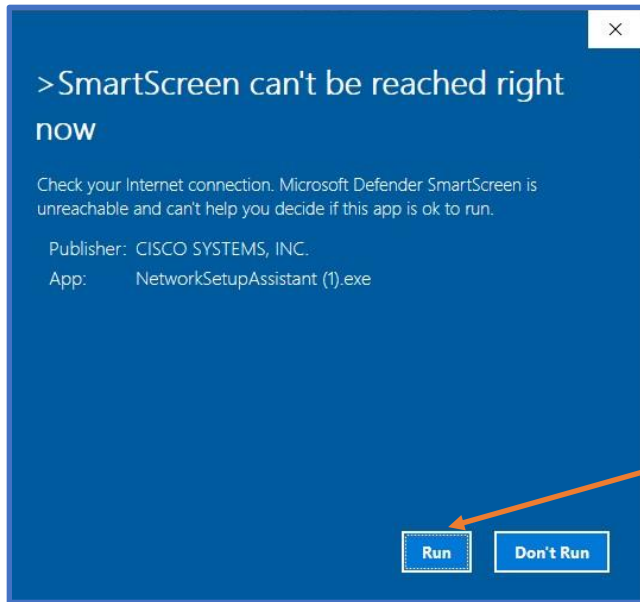


Enter a device name.

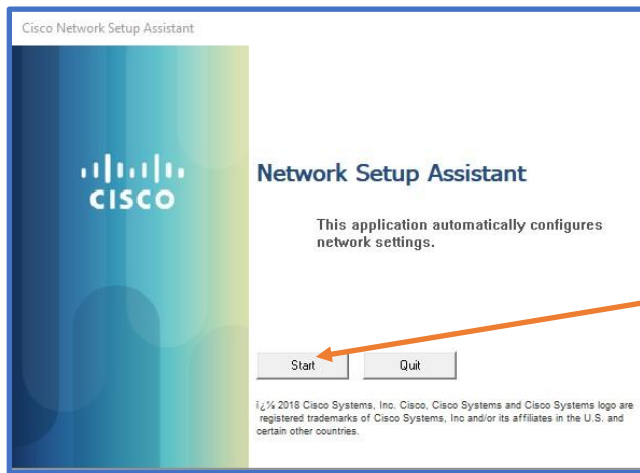
Click **Continue**.



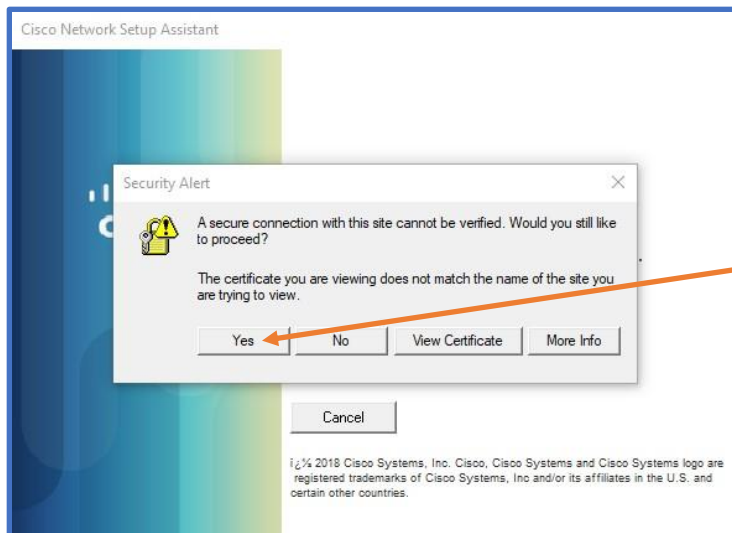
This will start a download. Find that downloaded file and run it. This can be done in the browser or file manager.



A warning will pop up stating that Windows is not online and cannot verify the file you are running. Click **Run**, as this is required to continue.



**Start** the Network Setup Assistant.



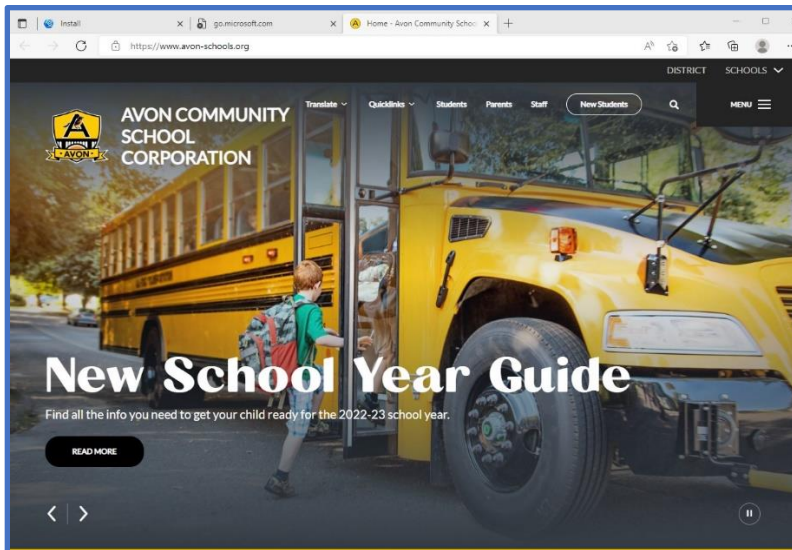
Click **Yes** to acknowledge the security alert.



This is the certificate that allows your computer to work on the Avon network. Click **Yes**.



The Network Setup Assistant will run and eventually show this screen. Click **Exit** and a new browser window will open.
