### 3. Construction Meeting July 6, 2022

Robert Grasis updated the committee relative to the June 22nd and July 6th construction meetings: there were no safety issues to report and federal/CDC COVID procedures are being followed; there is no update on disc filter #3 tripping status and the electrical subcontractor is working with Tighe & Bond to obtain the proper sized replacements to fit into the existing buckets; Jim Farese has replaced Ben Berthaime as Methuen's Project Manager; there is no change in the schedule impact since the last update; information continues to be obtained regarding the generator/PT issue; a meeting to discuss specifics regarding the carbon reduction period was held on Monday with all parties; and the vendor is working to resolve the issues for the emulsion polymer system. Also, there is no delay from Kruger for shipping the IFAS media.

# 3. Summary of Activities

Robert Grasis reviewed a summary of activities that included:

- Mixer testing was performed on Aeration Tanks #1, #2, #3 & #4
- Aeration PCCP pipe was replaced, leak tested and put into service June 24<sup>th</sup>, bypass is now complete
- Replaced plant water line over PCCP and installed isolation valves approved by BAC
- Fabrication and install of new discharge/influent header pipe for aeration blowers is ongoing
- Working continues in the secondary sludge, solids and blower buildings

- Conduit rough-ins and instrumentation install for the aeration area is continuing
- Startup of the new dewatering pump is complete
- Patching of old rebar in the north distribution channel is complete
- Secured polymer for RDT's for next week's startup
- Plant personnel were able to replace bent stem on aeration discharge gate #3 while PCCP and channel was empty
- Excavation work began for concrete piers for IMLR piping
- Step feed bypass gate install
- WAS header work was completed; replace plug valves and flow meter
- North UV channel concrete work and repair; concrete was poured on 7/6
