What an amazingly fun last week at the Elementary School!



EDTECH - SEESAW DIGITAL PORTFOLIOS, BACKING UP IPADS / APPLE IDS

Seesaw Digital Portfolios



At the end of each school year we suggest downloading your child's Seesaw digital portfolio in order to save a copy of their work for your own records.

 The download folder could be quite large depending on how many videos, audio files and images your child has put onto Seesaw, so please make sure you give yourself some time to complete the downloading process.

Here are the steps to complete it: <u>How</u> <u>families and students can download an</u> <u>archive of work</u>

Backing up work and other data on iPads

• For all children with iPads, please ensure any important data - photos, videos, work saved on the device - is saved to either another device, the child's school Google Drive, or iCloud. For children leaving ABA, please see these steps **to transfer any work and data** from their school Google account to a new account or device

Removing the school-provided Apple ID

- If your child is leaving ABA or,
- If your child is in Grade 5 and moving to the Middle School

Please contact **iwhite@abaoman.org** to arrange the iPad to be erased of all data, apps and settings in order to **<u>create a new Apple ID</u>**, or to use an existing one.

If you are already using a family Apple ID then there is no need to contact the school for this process.




FROM THE UNIVERSITY COUNSELOR

A great way to extend your learning and make an impression on your university application is to showcase how you have used your spare time and what you have gained from the experiences. Use your SUMMER time wisely	All Students Catch up on your reading! Explore virtual and in-person summer programmes. Visit university campuses if you can. Take an online course (including MOOCs on Unifrog). Engage in further career exploration. Learn a new skill or start a project. Support or initiate a cause that benefits others.
 Grade 9 Continue researching different careers (using Unifrog). Speak to family members about their professions. Set targets for increasing attainment levels. 	Grade 10 • Read IB guides for courses you will be taking next year. • Continue to research study destinations. • Continue to read about fields of interest. • Get more work experience if you can.
 Grade 11 Finalise your university application list on Unifrog Check programme entry requirements with care. Register to sit and practice for required tests (eg. UCAT, BMAT, LNAT, SAT). Take your English proficiency test (if required). Complete the first draft of your Personal Statement, CommonApp essay or Letter of Motivation. 	 Grade 12 Request the submission of any further official documents. Finalise visa application steps (if needed). Connect with the international office at your university. Check arrangements for the start of the Fall Semester. Start reading ahead in preparation the courses you will take.

'The French Omani Centre (CFO) is very happy to formalise its collaboration with ABA Oman International School. The DELF scolaire agreement signed between ABA and the Embassy of France in Oman will allow the organisation of official French language exams for ABA students. In order to prepare students for these exams, French courses will also be launched next September as part of the Foreign Language Programme and of the collaboration between ABA and CFO.'
