## PARENT INFO about Dayspring Dental's School Program

Dayspring's **mobile dental** program is entering the 2<sup>nd</sup> year of serving Whitley County schools. We are so grateful and honored you have entrusted us with the dental care of your children! Due to COVID-19, changes have been made to the program. We want to assure you we will be going **ABOVE and BEYOND** to provide dental care in the safest manner possible!

<b>NEW for dental staff:</b>	All dental staff will have a medical screening before each shift and will not work if sick.
	Minimal dental staff will work on site each day to accommodate 6-foot social distancing.
<b>NEW for children:</b>	All students will have their forehead temperature taken by dental staff before receiving dental treatment.
	We will minimize wait times to the best of our ability and be sure that students waiting are at least 6-feet from the treatment area.
	Students will wear a mask to the dental clinic, while waiting for treatment, and when returning to class. The mask will only be removed while the student is receiving dental treatment.
<b>NEW air filtration processes:</b>	Per state recommendations, we have purchased commercial-grade HEPA air filters. These are capable of cleaning the air in the entire classroom every 15 minutes and can filter down to a particle size smaller than the coronavirus.
<b>SAME excellent dental care:</b>	Dental staff will continue to wear full PPE (personal protective equipment) including gowns, gloves, and surgical masks.
	Dental staff will continue to practice diligent hand hygiene and will also make hand sanitizer available for children to use.
	Dental staff will continue to practice the same exceptional cleaning and sterilization procedures we have always followed, including use of a hospital-grade disinfectant cleaner, disposable plastic barriers to cover surfaces, and single-use disposable items on each child to avoid spreading germs.
<b>NEW option for N.T.I. families:</b>	<b>Our services are still available to children who will be doing school at home this year!!!</b> Please call us and we will schedule a time to see your child at our dental clinic! We are conveniently located across from Wal-Mart in Williamsburg. <b>Call (606) 765-6080</b> to make an appointment! Please let front desk know your child is a student and participating in Elgin program.
<b>IMPORTANT!</b>	If your child is having PAIN or PROBLEMS with his/her teeth, please call our office to expedite care. We want children out of pain, so they can learn as much as possible.
