Welcome to Wellington Prep School – we do hope you will be very happy with us.

All our children wear uniform which makes them look smart and part of our community. Different ages wear different items to allow for appropriate age-related activities and play.

Whilst we endeavour to keep changes to a minimum, our uniform is always reviewed on a regular basis and improvements are made as appropriate. Please take this into consideration if choosing to purchase uniform in advance.

Our uniform supplier is Schoolblazer (<u>www.schoolblazer.com</u>) and they have a very clever intelligent sizing system, which will help you with ordering.

All items of clothing and equipment should be clearly labelled. When ordering your uniform from Schoolblazer, they will offer to label your items and automatically add the correct number of name tags to your basket.

General Principles on Uniform and Appearance

Smart, appropriate uniform and high standards of personal presentation are important parts of our school life and ethos. Uniform is compulsory and children are encouraged and expected to look smart.

Shoes

Children in Nursery can wear comfortable, practical shoes or trainers. In all other year groups shoes must be flat, black and plain. Patent leather is allowed, but please avoid shoes with gimmicks such as flashing soles. In the summer plain sandals are acceptable (with closed toes, please).

Hair

Hair must be kept neat and tidy, either above the collar, or tied back if long enough to do so. Simple, blue accessories may be used to keep hair tidy. No extreme fashion cuts, dyes or colourings are allowed. Any exceptions must be discussed and agreed with the Head.

Jewellery and Nail Polish

Jewellery is discouraged in school. Watches are acceptable and so are Fitbits (or similar). Plain stud earrings may be worn, but these must be removed for sport. No other jewellery is allowed apart from that worn for specific religious purposes. As with all personal property brought in to the School, these items are the responsibility of the child and parents. No items of high value should be brought in to school. Nail polish is not to be worn.

Hot Weather

During periods of particularly hot weather the School will move to 'Shirt sleeve order'. During this time, blazers and ties are not worn. Children wear either short sleeved white shirts or roll up long sleeves (to sit above the elbow).

For the Summer term and the first half of the Autumn term, the school summer dress may be worn. A blazer or cardigan may be worn with this.

- School navy hoodie*

Wellington Prep School has three distinct uniforms which will enable us to make suitable provision for a pupil who wants to make a thoughtful and considered choice about the clothes worn at school in relation to clothing preferences or gender identity. The choice would be to wear the full Uniform A, B or C on a permanent basis, not a combination of all.

UNIFORM A

Winter Uniform

- Blazer* (from Year 3)
- Tartan school pinafore* for Reception, Year 1,2,3 & 4
- Tartan kilt* For Years 5 and 6
- White shirt (revere collar available from main department stores)
- School cardigan* Reception Year 4
- School jumper* Year 5/6
- Navy blue tights or knee length navy socks

Summer Uniform (Optional from April – October)

- School summer dress* or short sleeve shirt and kilt.
- School cardigan* (as above)
- White ankle socks (not trainer socks)



UNIFORM B

Winter Uniform

- Blazer* (from Year 3)
- Tartan trousers*
- White shirt (revere collar available from main department stores)
- School cardigan* Reception Year 4
- School jumper* Year 5/6
- Navy or black socks

Summer Uniform (Optional from April – October)

- School summer dress* or short sleeve shirt and kilt.*
- School cardigan* (as above)
- White ankle socks (not trainer socks)



UNIFORM C

- Blazer* (from Year 3)
- Dark grey trousers or shorts (No cargo pockets)
- White shirts
- School jumper*
- School tie* (elasticated up to Year 3)
- Navy socks (long socks/knee length if wearing shorts)

For the summer term, short sleeved white shirts can be worn (with tie).



SPORTS KIT

Reception, Year 1 & 2

- School navy hoodie* Reception, Year 1 & Year 2
- School polo shirt* Reception, Year 1 & Year 2
- Navy shorts Reception, Year 1 & Year 2
- Navy jogging bottoms Reception, Year 1 & Year 2
- White ankle socks
- Trainers
- School swimming bag*
- Navy blue swimming costume / trunks / jammers
- Swimming hat

<u>Year 3 – 6</u>

Wellbeing

All children from Year 3 need Wellbeing Kit on a weekly basis. Training pants (tracksuit bottoms) or PE shorts or a skort, a polo shirt, tracksuit top, sports socks *

Optional base layers and mid layers *



Sports Kit

The children need additional kit depending on which sport they are focusing on which term.

Autumn Term

- Boys rugby rugby top, rugby shorts, games socks*, shin pads, gum shield, rugby boots
- Girls Hockey -gum shield, shin pads, games socks, hockey stick





Spring term

- Boys hockey- gum shield, shin pads, games socks, hockey stick
- Girls Netball no extra kit needed

Summer term

- Cricket and Athletics
- Whites for children representing the school in Years 5 and 6


