Course Offerings

<p>Credit Recovery for English, Mathematics, Science, and History courses</p>	<p>Credit recovery courses will be offered in English, mathematics, science, and history subject areas. Credit recovery is an option that allows students to participate in targeted remediation in areas that they did not pass in the subject area throughout the school year. If the student successfully completes this remediation through the credit recovery program they will then receive the standard credit for completion of the course.</p> <p>PHS school counselors and administrators will contact students that are in need of utilizing this program in order to get credit for a course that they failed.</p> <p>Parents can also reach out to school counselors to register their student for a credit recovery course if they are eligible to participate.</p> <p>Dates: July 6 – August 4, 2022 (Mon – Thurs) Hours: 8:00am - 1:25pm Location: Poquoson Elementary School Tuition: No charge</p>
<p>PE 9/Health and PE 10/Driver Education</p>	<p>These classes will be taught in a blended setting (on-site followed by online). The classes will run from July 6 – August 4, 2022 on site at Poquoson Elementary School, Monday – Thursday (no classes on Fridays). August 8 – August 18, 2022 will be completed virtually (online) by the students. Students will be required to complete 20 hours per week online from August 8 – August 18, 2022. Students will need to be able to access a computer with internet capabilities in order to participate in this class.</p> <p>On-Site Dates: July 6 – August 4, 2022 (Mon – Thurs) On-Site Hours: 8:00am - 1:25pm On-Site Location: Poquoson Elementary School Tuition: \$450.00 for Poquoson residents</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Make checks payable to Poquoson Instructional Support.</u> • Fees may also be paid online by navigating to the School Division Website, selecting Parents/Students, selecting Student Fees, selecting Pay Student Fees Online, and finally selecting Summer School. There is a 4% service charge for those that choose to pay online. • Tuition must be paid in full at the time of registration. Registration not paid by 4:00pm June 3, 2022 will be considered late. No late registrations will be accepted. • Tuition is nonrefundable if a student withdraws from the course or is dismissed from summer school due to an absence, tardy or discipline problem. Tuition will be reimbursed if PCPS cancels the class due to insufficient enrollment. <p>Students will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Courses will be cancelled if there is insufficient enrollment. If the course is cancelled, parents will be notified by June 6, 2022.</p> <p>There will be additional fees for field trips.</p> <p>Students must turn 16 years of age during the school year following the summer in which they take PE 10 & Driver Education</p> <p>These classes are dependent on both student enrollment and teacher availability to teach the course. A final decision will be made on June 3, 2022 to determine if these courses will be held.</p> <p>Registration forms are available in the counseling offices of Poquoson Middle School and Poquoson High School.</p>

**Virtual Virginia
Courses that offer
Original Credit**

Students have the opportunity to participate in new courses for original credit through the online Virtual Virginia Program. Virtual Virginia offers 90 online courses available to all learners in grades 6-12. Students can work from any location in which they have a computer and a reliable internet connection (this does allow students to travel over the summer and still be able to complete course work). However, students are expected to log on every day that summer school is in session (June 15th – July 29th).

Virtual education programs provide additional instruction choices for students in non-traditional settings through distance learning options. These online learning programs offer flexibility to students while providing instruction aligned with the Standards of Learning. VDOE's Virtual Virginia Program offers a wide variety of classes in order to meet the needs of students who otherwise may be unable to take a course. Tuition: \$375 per course

- Enrollment fees must be paid with an electronic debit, credit, or prepaid card through the Parent Auditor Account (PAA) located on the Virtual Virginia website. Virtual Virginia accepts VISA, MasterCard, or Discover.
- The parent will receive an email for this account with the login instructions from Virtual Virginia once the student has been registered for their summer course.
- If a student's Summer Session enrollment fee is not paid by 8:00am on June 15, 2022, the student will be administratively withdrawn from the course.
- No refund will be issued if a course is dropped after 3:00pm on June 15, 2022
