

LEGACY JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL CLUB RULES

A school retains the right to create a closed forum at any time by allowing curricular clubs only. [UCA §§53A-11-1203 et seq. - Student Clubs Act]. All clubs must be compliant with the rules of the State Board of Education and the policies of the school governing board.

CLUB MEMBERSHIP: [53A-11-1209]

Membership in a Legacy Junior High School club will be limited to students registered at Legacy Junior High School.

FACULTY OVERSIGHT: [53A-11-1207]

All clubs authorized at Legacy Junior High School must have a faculty sponsor. The faculty sponsor shall:

- Organize and direct the purpose and activities of a curricular club.
- Provide oversight to ensure compliance with the approved club purposes, goals, activities, and compliance with state and district requirements and guidelines.
- If a religious noncurricular club is organized, the faculty advisor may not participate in club proceedings.
- Without the prior approval by the school, a person who is not a school faculty member or a club member may not:
 - Make a presentation to a noncurricular club
 - Direct, conduct, control, or regularly attend the meetings of a noncurricular club

USE OF SCHOOL FACILITIES BY CLUBS: [53A-11-1208]

- A School shall assign school building use for curricular and noncurricular clubs consistent with the needs of the school.
 - In assigning school use, the administrator may give priority to curricular clubs over noncurricular clubs
 - A school shall only provide the space for noncurricular clubs and may not spend public funds for noncurricular clubs.
- All club flyers must be approved by school administration.
- All club flyers must only be posted on bulletin boards by the Legacy main office staff.
- All club PA announcements must be approved by the administration.

APPEALS –PROCEDURES: [53-11-1212]

- If an application is denied, a written reasons for the denial shall be stated.
- A parent, guardian, or student has 10 school days from the date of denial, suspension, or termination of a club to file a written appeal to a designee authorized by the school governing board.
- The designee shall issue a determination within a reasonable amount of time form receipt of the appeal, which decision is final and constitutes satisfaction of all administrative remedies.
