

IT'S NOT TOO LATE TO APPLY!

Free and reduced-price school meals are provided by the National School Lunch Program (NSLP).

This federally assisted meal program allows students whose families meet certain income requirements to receive all school meals including breakfast and lunch for free or at a reduced price. Apply today so your child can have healthy, nutritious meals every day at school, while saving you money.



Eligibility for free or reduced-price meals is determined by your household size and income level.

If the family household income (for a household of five people for example) is less than \$60,070 annually (\$5,006 monthly or \$1,156 weekly), you may qualify for reduced-price meals. Even if you are not sure of your child's eligibility, please apply as there is no cost or risk for application.

Are there any restrictions based on immigration status?

No! There are no immigration restrictions for this program and undocumented immigrants may receive free meals as well. The information collected in the application is confidential and will be used only for evaluating the eligibility of students for free school meals. Since free and reduced-price meals qualify as a non-cash benefit, receiving them will not prevent immigrants from receiving a "green card" or legal permanent residence.
