Mr. Stenftenagel gave an update on projects---

Mr. Stenftenagel asked the Board to approve the bid to replace the roof at Cabby O'Neill Gym. The roof material will not be available until January 2023. The project finish date is the spring of 2023. Mr. Stenftenagel asked the Board to approve the low bid from Midwest Roofing and Insulation for the amount of \$216,500. This amount includes the Alternate for a protective file that will remain on the

surface of the new TPO membrane to protect and it and clean during tear-off installation activities. Once the new TPO is installed, the protective membrane is removed.

Mr. Schnaus asked if the building is getting used a lot.

Dr. Lorey stated yes. Boys' basketball, dance teams, and other ECA groups. The Park & Recreation are using the gym too.

Mr. DeMotte asked if the gym had been switched to LED Lighting.

Dr. Lorey stated she would have to check on the lighting.

A motion by Arlet Jackle, second by Greg Eckerle, to approve the bid from Midwest Roofing and Insulation for \$216,500.00 for the replacement of the Cabby Gym roof, was unanimously approved by the Board.

Mr. Stenftenagel stated the building will be more energy efficient and should last 20 years without worrying about leaks.

Mr. Stenftenagel asked the Board to approve Schmidt Associates to develop plans and specification for HVAC improvements at Jasper High School. The improvements are as follows:

The total estimated project is \$2.5 million.

Other Business:

Dr. Lorey asked the Board to approve the 2022-2023 Book Rental and Course fees.

A motion by Arlet Jackle, second by Ken Schnaus, to approve the 2002-2023 Book Renal and Course fees, was unanimously approved by the Board.

Dr. Lorey asked the Board to approve an increase in the daily food per diem for travel reimbursement from \$35.00 per day to \$50.00 per day.

A motion by Arlet Jackle, second by Ken Schnaus, to approve the increase in travel, was unanimously approved by the Board.

Dr. Lorey shared the year end reports from the school social workers and nursing services.

Dr. Lorey asked the Board to approve the 2022-2023 Teacher Evaluation Plan.

A motion by Ken Schnaus, second by Arlet Jackle, to approve the 2022-2023 Teacher Evaluation Plan, was unanimously approved by the Board.

Dr. Lorey asked the Board to approve the support staff wage scales, salaries and top of scale stipends. She asked the Board to amend the amounts of paid vacation time for the 260 day employees. This would provide 1 week for qualifying employees in the first year. Two weeks for employees in years 2-4 and 3 weeks of paid vacation for employees with 5 or more years of service.

A motion by Ken Schnaus, second by Greg Eckerle, to approve the wage scale increases and amend the other benefits listed above, was unanimously approved by the Board. The wage scales are enclosed.

Dr. Lorey asked the Board to approve the professional development/course work reimbursement program for cafeteria staff.

A motion by Tim DeMotte, second by Arlet Jackle, to approve the cafeteria professional development/course work reimbursement, was unanimously approved by the Board.

Dr. Lorey asked the Board to approve the Public Participation at Board Meetings policy effective July 1, 2022.

Last month the Board received proposed revision to Policy 0167.3 pertaining to public participation at Board Meetings. The proposed changes reflect changes made to the Indiana Open Door Law and Notice of meetings of Board Members. Effective July 1, an opportunity for public comment limited to an item on the Board Meeting Agenda will be afforded. Those wishing to make comment will be required to register their intent upon arrival by signing up to speak. At the designated time, the participant must state their name, address, and group affiliation (if applicable). Time is limited to 3 minutes per person not to exceed 30 minutes of duration for the public comment section of the meeting. No participant may pass their time to another participant. The policy pertaining to a member of the public placing an item on the Board Agenda remains the same.

A motion by Tim DeMotte, second by Greg Eckerle, to approve the public participation at Board Meetings effective July 1, 2022, was unanimously approved by the Board.

Dr. Lorey asked the Board to approve the district plan revision based upon census information. Upon completion of the recent census, government entities with elected officials must review their organization plans as a reflection of the current population served. After review of the current census statistics, Mr. Nordhoff provided an updated organization plan. The proposed change provides further detail for the residence districts that the board represents, as well as updates the changes to election at the Primary election and dates of Board Members terms. Mr. Nordhoff sent the information to the State of Indiana for review.

Mr. Schnaus expressed his concern about the City of Jasper having more weight in the process than the rural areas.

Dr. Lorey stated the Board is represented by townships.

Mr. Schnaus stated Jasper district could get a Madison or Boone Township seat.

Mr. Eckerle and Mrs. Jackle stated the person has to live in the township.

A motion by Tim DeMotte, second by Greg Eckerle, to approve the district plan revision subject to State approval, the vote 4-1 with Ken Schnaus voting no.

Dr. Lorey made the following announcements:



There being no further business to conduct and upon a motion by Greg Eckerle, second by Ken Schnaus, the Board voted to adjourn at 7:41 p.m.







Professional Development/Course Work Reimbursement

A. Professional Development

USDA Continuing Education Units (CEUs) Requirements

- a. In accordance with USDA Professional Standards for school nutrition professionals, which is a key provision of the Healthy Hunger-Free Kids Act of 2010 (HHFKA), a minimum amount of annual training hours are required for all school nutrition program staff. Greater Jasper Consolidated Schools is mandated to annually meet these USDA regulations for training and development of school nutrition professionals.

Current minimum requirements are the following:

- Part time staff with a regular schedule of less than 20 hours per week must complete a minimum of 4 hours (4 CEUs).
- Staff with a regular schedule of 20 hours or more each week must complete a minimum of 6 hours (6 CEUs).
- Cafeteria Managers must complete a minimum of 10 hours (10 CEUs).

B. Reimbursement

- a. During the school year, employees will be required to complete the mandated training on their own time. Trainings shall not conflict with the employee's workday.
- b. Employees will be paid for each CEU earned up to the employee's required minimum. The rate of pay will be one (1) hour per CEU at the employee's hourly rate. Payment will be made upon submission of completion of all required CEUs on or before May 31 of each school year.
- c. Employees can earn CEUs during inservice professional development training sessions scheduled by the district's Food Service Coordinator. The district may provide some professional development opportunities.
- d. Documentation of CEU hours will be required by each staff member on an annual basis.
- e. Trainings may be from the Institute of Child Nutrition (ICN), John Stalker Institute (JSI), School Nutrition Association (SNA), Indiana School Nutrition Association (ISNA), or other USDA approved training sites.
- f. The district's Food Service Coordinator may assign specific training to employees. Required training topic areas will vary according to position, job requirements and program needs. Training must be completed annually between July 1 and May 31. All training must be approved prior to attending any training.

- g. Failure of the employee to meet their minimum required annual training CEUs will prevent the employee from advancing on the cafeteria payscale after the first occurrence. If an employee fails to meet their minimum requirements for annual training CEUs two (2) school years, consecutive or nonconsecutive, the employee may be subject to termination.

C. Professional Growth Incentive

- a. Certification Program - All employees are encouraged to develop standards of excellence in school nutrition through continuing education. The School Nutrition Association (SNA) offers a leveled certification program (Level 1, 2, 3, 4).
- b. All Cafeteria Managers will be required to achieve, at a minimum, Level 1 Certification through the School Nutrition Association (SNA).
- c. Upon certificate attainment, an hourly rate increase will be paid to any employee who successfully achieves and maintains level certifications. The employee must provide copies of CEU certificates, receipt of payment to SNA, a copy of their certificate level letter and any other pertinent documentation. Employees must submit documentation of maintenance of their certification level annually in order to continue to receive the hourly rate increase. Failure to properly maintain any level certification will result in a forfeiture of the hourly pay increase incentive. Documentation must be received by May 31 of each year.

Hourly rate increases are as follows:

- Level 1 SNA Certification - \$0.35 per hour
 - Level 2 SNA Certification - \$0.50 per hour
 - Level 3 SNA Certification - \$0.75 per hour
 - Level 4 SNA Certification - \$1.00 per hour
- d. The district will pay the annual School Nutrition Association membership fees for employees, however, it is the responsibility of the employee to pay any application and renewal fees.

D. Food Safety Certification

- a. All Cafeteria Managers are required to be certified in food safety. The registration fee, material cost, and exam fee will be paid for by the district. In the event the employee fails to pass the certification exam, any fees associated with retaking the exam are the responsibility of the employee. Employees who fail to pass the food safety certification exam after three (3) attempts will be subject to termination.

School Operations During the Covid-19 Endemic

June 27, 2022

Our schools have worked diligently over the past 2 years to implement measures that would afford a safe learning environment and minimize the exposure to Covid-19 for students and staff.

On February 17, 2022, the ISDH announced that *schools would no longer be required to contact trace close contacts of positive students*. They indicated that the value and feasibility of contact tracing has waned. They cited asymptomatic and mild cases, unknown infection, shorter incubation periods and pandemic fatigue as reasons to eliminate this process.

In essence, Covid-19 has shifted from a pandemic to an endemic like other illnesses that we manage throughout the year such as the flu.

As a result, beginning Monday, February 21, 2022 Greater Jasper Consolidated Schools will no longer be quarantining and excluding from school close contacts of individuals who test positive for Covid-19.

Individuals who test positive for Covid-19 must still notify the school and will still be required to follow the guidance below:

Isolation/Quarantine Guidance

COVID-19 Positive

- Isolate at home for 5 days
- Return on day 6 if symptoms improved
- Wear a mask in all school settings except while eating or drinking for 5 additional days.

*Must be fever free for 24 hours without fever reducing medication.

Virtual learning options will only be available to students who are isolating due to a verified case of Covid-19.

GJCS will no longer provide BinaxNOW rapid testing for individuals.

Individuals may seek testing through other local sources.

PLAN FOR
GREATER JASPER CONSOLIDATED SCHOOLS

1. As used herein the word "plan" shall have the meaning defined in IC 20-4-10.1-1 (Burns Indiana Statutes 28-1831) and all provisions of the present plan of Greater Jasper Consolidated Schools not inconsistent or in conflict with the changes set out herein shall continue in full force and effect.

2. BOARD OF SCHOOL TRUSTEES, NUMBER. The Board of School Trustees shall consist of five (5) in number.

3. RESIDENCE DISTRICTS. For the purpose of selecting the School Trustees, the school corporation shall be divided into the following residence districts, all in Dubois County, Indiana:

District #1 -- Madison Township
District #2 -- Boone Township
District #3 -- City of Jasper
District #4 -- Bainbridge Township and
including City of Jasper

4. RESIDENCE OF MEMBERS OF BOARD OF TRUSTEES. One (1) member of the Board of Trustees shall reside in District #1; one (1) member shall reside in District #2; one (1) member shall reside in District #4; and two (2) members shall reside in District #3.

5. ELECTION. The Board of Trustees shall be elected by a vote of all registered voters of Greater Jasper Consolidated Schools voting at any school board member election. The first election at which any member of the Board of School Trustees shall be elected will be the Primary Election of 1976.

6. ELECTED AT PRIMARY ELECTIONS. Members of the Board shall be elected at Primary Elections and all registered voters of the Greater Jasper Consolidated Schools shall be entitled to cast a vote for a Board member from each of the residence districts in the school corporation.

7. INITIAL ELECTIONS. At the Primary Election in 1976, one (1) member of the Board shall be elected from each of the following residence districts:

District #1
District #2
District #3
District #4

At said election the Board member from residence District #1 shall serve for an initial term of two (2) years. Members elected from Residence Districts #2, #3, and #4 shall serve for an initial term of four (4) years.

Thereafter said board member from residence District #1 shall be elected at the Primary Election in 1978 and shall serve for a term of four (4) years.

At the Primary Election in 1978, one (1) member of the Board shall be elected from District #3 who shall serve for an initial term of four (4) years. The person so elected from District #3 shall replace the

present Board member appointed for a four (4) year term beginning July 1, 1974.

8. TERMS OF MEMBERS. All elected Board members shall take office and assume their duties on the 1st day of July following their election.

After the initial election, all members shall be elected for terms of four (4) years and until their successors have been elected and qualified.

9. INTERIM APPOINTMENTS. The appointees appointed to the present Board of Trustees for terms beginning July 1, 1975 shall serve for a term of only one (1) year.

10. QUALIFICATIONS OF MEMBERS, OATH. The members of the Board of School Trustees shall be at least twenty one (21) years of age, residents of the district from which they are elected at the time of election, and residents of the district from which they are elected for at least one (1) year preceding their taking office. They shall be ineligible to any elective or appointive office under such Board of School Trustees and under the government of Dubois County or any township therein which holding membership on said Board.

Every school trustee-elect shall, within three (3) days after beginning his term of office, take an oath before some one qualified to administer oaths that he possesses all of the qualifications required to be eligible as trustee of the Greater Jasper Consolidated Schools, and that he will honestly and faithfully discharge the duties of his office. Upon the taking of such oath, the School Turstee shall be deemed to have qualified for such office.

11. VACANCY. If a vacancy shall occur on the Board of Trustees it shall be filled for the remaining portion of the unexpired term by appointment by the remaining members of the Board.

12. This Plan shall take effect on April 1, 1975.

The Board of School Trustees of the Greater Jasper Consolidated Schools, pursuant to I.C. 20-23-8-8.5, as amended, does hereby certify that its current Corporation Plan, being an amended Plan approved by said Board on June 27, 2022, of an original Plan previously approved by the Indiana State Board of Education on October 23, 1974, establishing four (4) residential Districts for the election of five (5) members of the Board of School Trustees of said School Corporation, with each Board member being elected by a vote of all registered voters of said School Corporation voting at any school board member election, does hereby certify that said Plan has been adopted and proposed pursuant to I.C. 20-23-4-22 does not require any additional current amendment to comply with Indiana Code. A copy of the School Corporation's amended Plan has been submitted to the Circuit Court Clerk of Dubois County, Indiana, and to the State Board for approval, a copy of which is attached.

PLAN FOR

1. As used herein the word "plan" shall have the meaning defined in I.C. 20-4-10.1-1 (Burns Indiana Statutes 28-1831) and all provisions of the present plan of Greater Jasper Consolidated Schools not inconsistent or in conflict with the changes set out herein shall continue in full force and effect.

2. BOARD OF SCHOOL TRUSTEES, NUMBER. The Board of School Trustees shall consist of five (5) in number.

3. RESIDENCE DISTRICTS. For the purpose of selecting the School Trustees, the School Corporation shall be divided into the following residence districts, all in Dubois County, Indiana:

District #1- Madison Township, including that portion thereof located in the City of Jasper, in Madison Township;

District #2- Boone Township, including that portion thereof located in the City of Jasper, in Boone Township;

District #3- City of Jasper, to the extent located in Bainbridge Township; and,

District #4- Bainbridge Township and including the City of Jasper to the extent located in Bainbridge Township.

4. RESIDENCE OF MEMBERS OF BOARD OF TRUSTEES. One (1) member of the Board of Trustees shall reside in District #1; one (1) member shall reside in District #2; one (1) member shall reside in District #4; and two (2) members shall reside in District #3.

5. ELECTION. The Board of Trustees shall be elected by a vote of all registered voters of Greater Jasper Consolidated Schools voting at any school board member election. The first election at which any member of the Board of School Trustees was elected was in the Primary Election of 1976.

6. ELECTED AT GENERAL ELECTIONS. Members of the Board shall be elected at General Elections and all registered voters of the Greater Jasper Consolidated Schools shall be entitled to cast a vote for a Board member from each of the residence districts in the School Corporation.

7. ELECTION DATES. From and after the General Election in 2022, members of the Board shall be elected from each of the following residence districts in the following manner:

District #1- Madison Township, including area within the City of Jasper, located in the Madison Township;

District #2- Boone Township, including area within the City of Jasper, located in Boone Township;

District #3- City of Jasper, including only that portion of Jasper, located in Bainbridge Township; and,

District #4- Bainbridge Township, excluding Jasper located in Boone or Madison Township

Members elected from Residence Districts #1, #2, #3 and #4 shall serve for a term of four (4) years.

At the General Election in 2022, one (1) member of the Board shall be elected each from District #1 and District #3; and in the General Election in 2024, one (1) Member shall be elected each from District #2, District #3 and District #4, and those currently serving from Districts #2, #4 and the second member serving from Section 3 shall continue to serve the remaining two (2) years of their current terms.

8. TERMS OF MEMBERS. All elected Board members shall take office and assume their duties on the 1st day of January following their election.

All members shall be elected for terms of four (4) years and until their successors have been elected and qualified.

9. QUALIFICATIONS OF MEMBERS, OATH. The members of the Board of School Trustees shall be at least twenty-one (21) years of age, residents of the district from which they are elected at the time of election, and residents of the district from which they are elected for at least one (1) year proceeding their taking office. They shall be ineligible to any elective or appointive office under such Board of School Trustees, but may be eligible for appointment to offices in the government of Dubois county or any Township or City therein while holding membership on said Board.

Every School Trustee-elect shall, within three (3) days after beginning their term of office, take an oath before someone qualified to administer oaths that he or she possesses all of the qualifications required to be eligible as Trustee of the Greater Jasper Consolidated Schools, and that he or she will honestly and faithfully discharge the duties of their office. Upon the taking

of such oath, the School Trustee shall be deemed to have qualified for such office.

10. VACANCY. If a vacancy shall occur on the Board of Trustees it shall be filled for the remaining portion of the unexpired term by appointment by the remaining members of the Board.
