



General Uniform Policies

All uniform items must be purchased from Educational Outfitters except for socks, tights, leggings, modesty shorts, shoes, belts, and turtlenecks. All outerwear must be St. Paul issued. This includes sweatshirts, pull-overs, vests, and jackets. These items can be purchased at the Saint Shop, Educational Outfitters, or the Used Uniform Sale. The exception is for heavier coats worn during carpool and on the playground only.

General Guidelines

Belts & Accessories:

- Belts must be plain brown or black, with no ornamentation and worn with pants/shorts that have belt loops (except for the elastic-waist pants with belt loops). Belts sold in the Saint Shop are considered in uniform.
- Girls may wear simple headbands in any color. Simple accessories are allowed: small earrings, necklaces, bracelets. Boys may not wear earrings.
- Makeup is not allowed.
- Hair must be neatly groomed. Boys' hair must be above the ear, off the collar in the back, and above the eyebrows.

Socks & Shoes:

- Socks must be crew, knee, or ankle socks in white or black with no logos or embellishments. Socks sold in the Saint Shop are considered in uniform.
- Leggings and tights must be plain and solid navy, white, black, or gray in a matte finish.
- Athletic shoes are required for physical education classes.
 - *Athletic* –must be primarily white, gray, black or blue; bright color accents are acceptable

Tops:

- Oxford shirts and overblouses may be worn with a solid white undershirt (boys and girls). No imprinted undershirts or t-shirts.

- Shirttails are to be neatly tucked in and buttons buttoned (including button-down collars).

Bottoms:

- Skirts, jumpers, dresses, skorts, and culottes should be no shorter than three inches above the knee (as measured when child is kneeling on the floor).
- Modesty shorts must be worn underneath jumpers, dresses, and skirts.
- The pants and shorts for boys and girls and the skirts, skorts, and culottes for girls should fit at the waist and be worn at the waist.
- The length of boys' shorts should not fall below the knee.

Sweaters, Vests, & Outerwear:

- Sweaters (cardigans or vests) are part of the required chapel uniform for 3rd-6th grade girls between Thanksgiving and Spring Break.
- The navy vest is part of the required dress uniform for JK-6th grade boys between Thanksgiving and Spring Break.
- All outerwear must be St. Paul issued. This includes sweatshirts, pull-overs, vests and jackets. These items can be purchased at the Saint Shop, Educational Outfitters, or the Used Uniform Sale. The exception is for heavier coats worn during carpool and on the playground only.

Students should always be in uniform, except for jeans/dress-up days.
