School-Issued iPads: All 6th graders will be issued an iPad by the school. This will be used as the primary agenda or "planner" ... but students can bring and use a hard-copy planner if they wish.

System of Organization:

Having a physical tool like a large accordion file, or a trapper-keeper is important for keeping class materials organized, separated, and easy to locate. Each student is able to choose what works best for her/him, but our experience is positive for students who use a file folder system. We suggest the same color folder and notebook for subjects (i.e. red folder and red notebook for math, yellow folder and yellow notebook for science, etc.)
