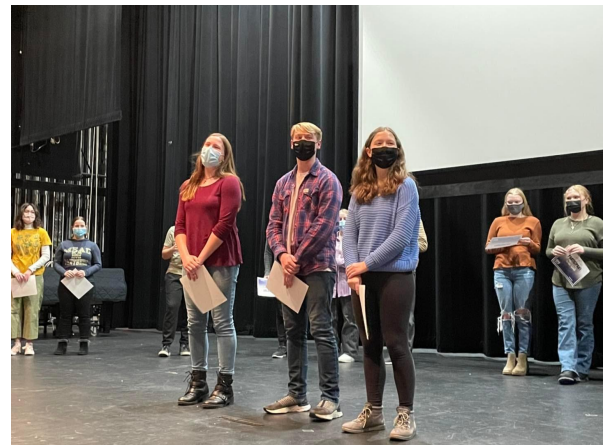

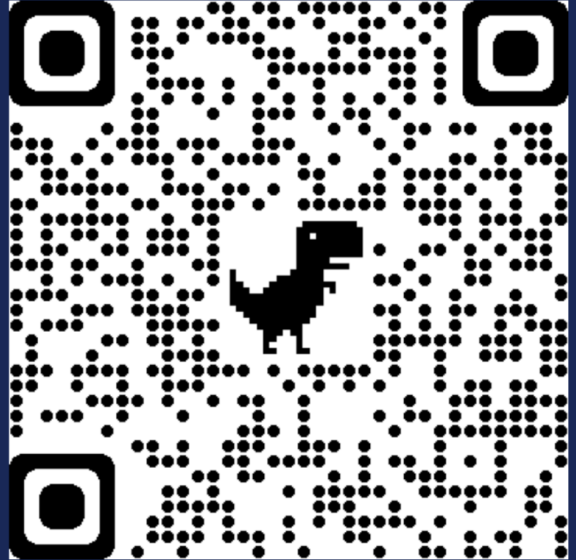

GYMNASTICS – After two cancellations, the Girls were able to compete in their GSL meet at Central Valley Wednesday. They ended up taking 1st, defeating 2nd place Mt. Spokane, 163 – 159.775. **Megan Davis** placed 1st on the Beam (9.100) and **Tabitha Pierce** was 3rd (8.850). **Annalise Thackston** was 3rd on the Floor (9.050).

WRESTLING – Mead defeated Lewis & Clark on Wednesday, 67-9 and Thursday, at North Central the Panthers topped the Wolfpack 51-18. This weekend, **Jake Mark** (145#), **Chris Grosse** (195#) and **JT Connors** (220#) all placed 1st and the **Panthers** took the **Team Title** at the **Clearwater Classic** held at Lewiston High School. Mead had twelve wrestlers place in the top 4 including **Taylor Pascua** and **Baylie Conner** in the Girls' Division.

BOYS & GIRLS BASKETBALL – The Boys traveled to Gonzaga Prep on Friday for their first game in 10 days and lost to the Bullpups, 70-29. The Girls, also playing for the first time in almost two weeks were led by **Haley Burns** (19 points) and **Olivia Moore** (15 points) in their 68 – 47 win over the Bullpups. Mead hosts Central Valley tomorrow (Tuesday). Both games will be televised on SWX.
