Need some clarification on the schedule? No worries.

- **Monday (4/19) & Tuesday (4/20)** are "Hybrid" days as usual.
- **Wednesday (4/21) & Thursday (4/22)** - Students learn at home on these days. No Zoom and students will work independently. Similar to our existing "at home" days. Asynchronous.
- **Friday, April 23rd** - All face-to-face students in grades 9-12 return in-person! Unless they are self-paced or remain remote.
- Curriculum Days on Friday, May 28th & Friday, June 11th. Students learn asynchronously "at home" these days. No Zoom.

ZOOM REMINDERS

When can my student access classes from home?

There may be times when a student who usually comes to school in-person needs to access classes from home. What situations are allowed for these students to remotely access their classes?

Situation #1 - A student is ill and needs to stay home.

Yes, students who are ill, and need to stay home, may access their classes remotely if they are able to do so.

Situation #2 - A student is quarantined at home due to COVID-19.

Yes, students who are under quarantine may access their classes remotely for the duration of their quarantine period.

Are there times when my student cannot access their classes from home?

Yes. Due to a set number of remote seats for students as outlined by contract, students who are on vacation or simply just at home without illness or not on quarantine will not be allowed to remotely access classes while away from school. They can still access Google Classroom for coursework and should communicate with their teachers. The only exceptions to remote into classes involve the aforementioned situations previously outlined (i.e. illness and quarantine).

Volleyball Teams were announced in March. **Jordynn Hutchinson, Sophia TurningRobe & Madi Zorn** were all **1st Team** members and **Mia Tunison** was a **2nd Team** selection.

Soccer – The Boys won twice during the first week of their season, 3-1 over Ferris and 3-0 over University. **Parker McKeen** scored twice against the Saxons and **Nathan Mahaffey** stopped a 1 v 1 breakaway to preserve the shutout over the Titans.

Golf – The Girls shot the low team score in last week's GSL opener finishing 1st, and the Boys were a close 2nd behind Gonzaga Prep. **Taylor Mularski's** 76, was the low round of the day. **Ty Anderson** (74) and **Bradley Mulder** (79) led the Panther Boys.

Baseball – The Panthers lost at Central Valley, 6-5 and won on Friday over University at Mead. **DJ Bowman** and **Dayton Wells** each drove in 3 runs, **Jackson Eckstrom** had 3 hits and scored 3 runs and **Levi Nicodemus** struck out 5 in the five inning 13-3 victory.

Tennis – Both the Boys and Girls Teams had wins in their League openers. The Boys defeated Ferris, 4-3 and the Girls won 6-1 over the Saxons. **Abby & Grace Sonnichsen** won their #1 doubles match over Hollins & Batrud 6-4, 6-1.

Track – Mead was the site for the first GSL Track Meet of the season and the Panthers were winners over Mt. Spokane. 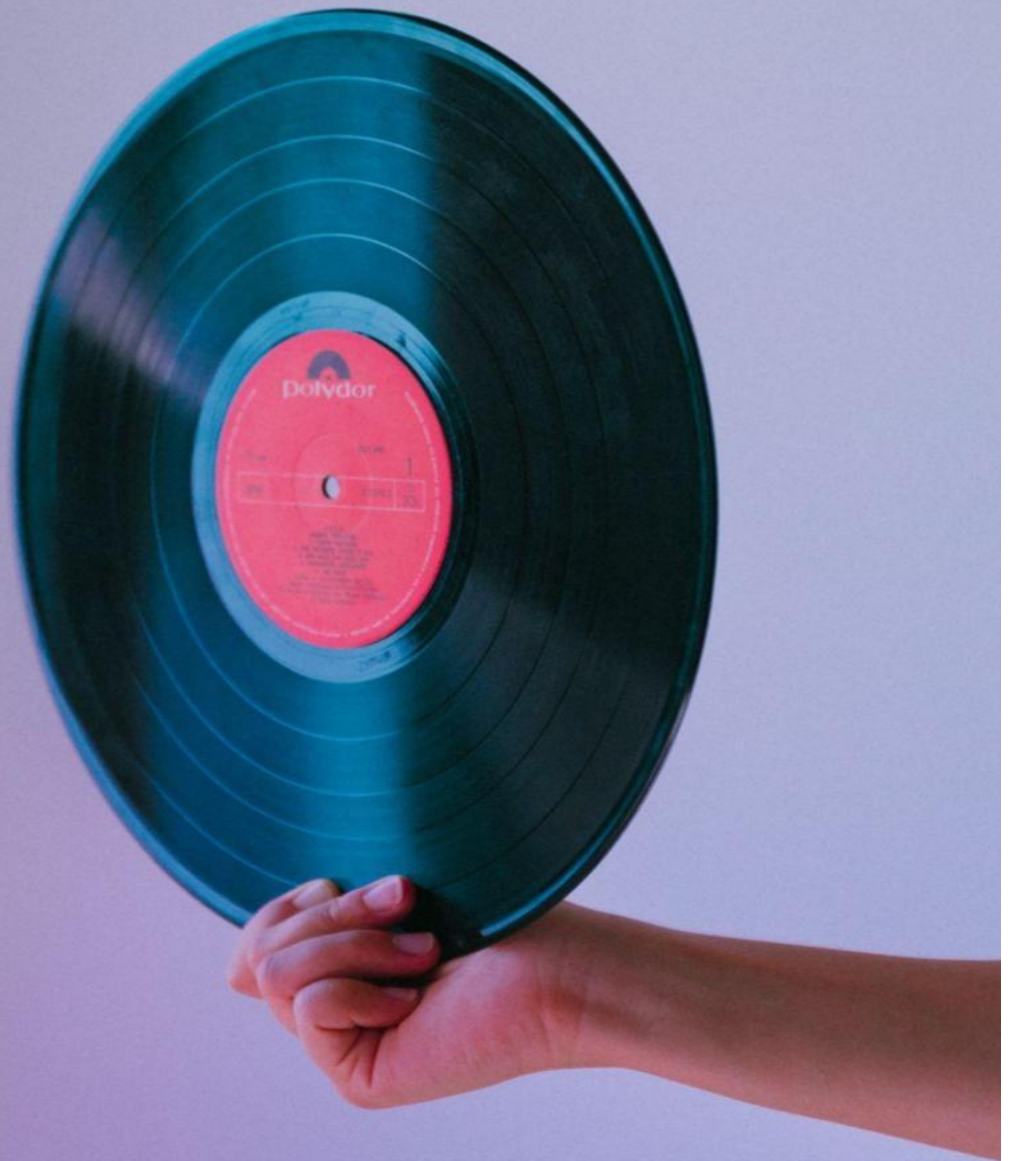
